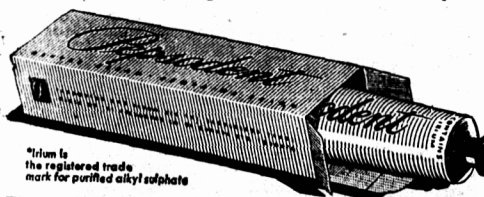

"What can we do with him?" Lessing stared at Dowson in contempt, but with sinister significance. The other shrank back as he read his thoughts.

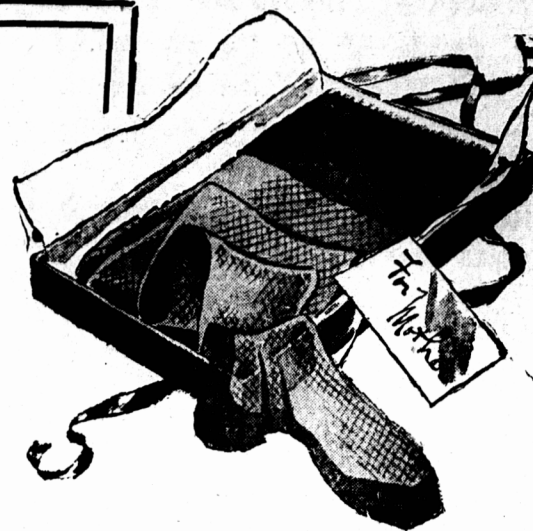
"We can't risk that again."

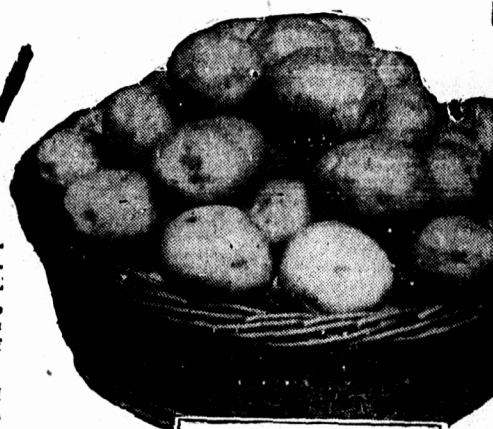
now I have achieved considerable success by accepting my own. But what, precisely, is it you refer to?"
