**Weather and Crop.**

WINNIPEG, Aug 29.—The weather throughout Manitoba and the Territories still continues fine, and favorable for harvesting. About one-third of the total crop is now cut. Threshing has commenced at Emerson and Gretna, and everywhere the sample of wheat is pronounced extra No 1 hard. This week will see most of Manitoba's wheat crop safely cut if present weather conditions continue. About 6,300 harvest helpers have arrived from the East and are now distributed over the province. Nearly twice as many came from the East as were expected. All will find employment.

**Plague Spreading.**

MADRID, Aug 29.—Dr. Vicente, who has returned here from Oporto, says that the situation in that city is grave. The plague shows an active tendency to spread.

BUCHAREST, Aug 29.—In consequence of the outbreak of the plague in Astrakhan, the Roumanian Government, has established a sanitary cordon along the Russian frontier.

LONDON, Aug 29.—Queen Victoria is said to have written to the widow of a British officer killed at the battle of Omdurman, having a posthumous baby, a letter of sympathy, concluding with the words:—

**Bull Fight at Boulogne.**

BOULOGNE, Aug 29.—There was a bull fight here to-day, at which six bulls and three horses were killed amid the usual horrors. There were 3,000 spectators, and many of the women fainted. One-third of those present withdrew in disgust. Hundreds of English tourists witnessed the fights.

**Kaiserin Again Indisposed.**

BERLIN, Aug 29.—The Lokal Anzeiger says Empress Augusta Victoria is again so indisposed that her physicians have forbidden her to accompany Emperor William to the autumn manoeuvres in South Germany.

**Birth of Goethe Celebrated.**

FRANKFORT-ON-MAIN, Aug 29.—The 150th anniversary of the birth of Goethe was celebrated by immense crowds here Saturday. The Goethe Plantz and statue were beautifully decorated.

WILL LOAD DEALS.—The steamer Gasperia has been fixed to load deals at Bathurst for Glasgow at 50s. The Gasperia's name is a familiar one now made so by her experience in the Gulf of St. Lawrence last winter.

PERMANENT BASIS.—According to a London cablegram arrangements are being made to put the Paspetic and Milford Haven steamship service on a permanent basis.

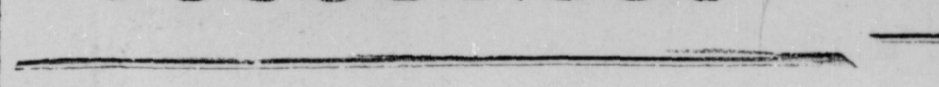
