Change Exerted on Weapons Policy

OTTAWA (CP) — Indications are that the government intends for the time being at least to stick to the nuclear weapons policy outlined in the Canadian Post, 26 by Prime Minister Diefenbaker.

CONTRACT BRIDGE

You are South, neither side vulnerable. The bidding has been:
East South West North
P Pass P Pass 1♥
What would you now bid with each of the following five hands?

- 1. ♠AKJH ♥Q83 ♦A13 ♣550
2. ♠Q84 ♥KQ72 ♦AQJ83 ♣2
3. ♠AQ93 ♥Q5 ♦AKJ ♣A9
4. ♠AK8643 ♥Q852 ♦KJ ♣A
5. ♠AKK ♠A9 ♠K ♠K982 ♠1

1. Pass. A layout of a double the nuclear family should not be increased so long as there is any possibility of disarmament.

2. Two hearts. The player who responds to the double (in this case, North) may have a poor hand, since he is merely showing partner's command that he bid. The doubler therefore has to tread gingerly when it comes to choosing his rebid.

3. One trump. This gives the best description of the balanced distribution, and, generally speaking, shows the high-card values for an opening no-trump bid.

4. Three hearts. There are only 13 high-card points, but the chances of making game with this hand are far better than those of the preceding rebid where there were 18 points.

5. Four hearts. This hand is also judged by the number of probable winners, but the chances of making ten tricks are so good that we bid the same ourselves without running the risk of partner's passing a lesser bid.

Canada won't live up to a commitment given NATO unless it accepts nuclear warheads for the RCAF air division and Canadian infantry brigade in Europe.

Authoritative sources say the latest John artillery battery with the Canadian Brigade in Europe has already been fully trained in the U.S. on nuclear weapons.

A comparable situation would exist in the air division when it was fully equipped later this year with the CF-104 low-level jet bomber. However, it was conceded the division couldn't be "fully" trained in handling nuclear warheads without a Canada-U.S. agreement.

Canadian-U.S. Common Market Said 'Dead Duck'

TORONTO (CP) — Michael Barkway, editor and publisher

of The Financial Times, said here that the concept of a Canadian - United States Common Market "is a dead duck—at least for the time being."

Mr. Barkway, speaking at the opening luncheon of the Canadian Furniture Mart, criticized theories that "seek a sort of cut-rate-brand of discount-house salvation for Canada by established free trade with the United States."

He said notions of economic union with the United States have been possible by economists as well as by politicians.

Mr. Barkway's remarks were contained in a speech released to the press in advance of the luncheon.

At the moment, therefore, the number appears willing to sacrifice a complete nuclear disarmament in the nuclear club.

Canada, he said, must open "all possible channels to all possible markets, including the United States and overseas countries, rather than subjecting us to a complete dependence on the United States."

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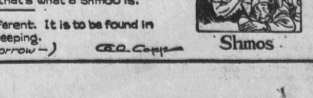
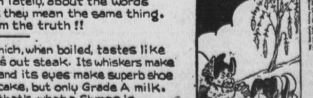
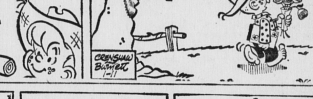
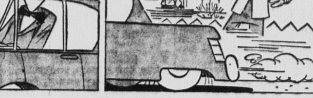
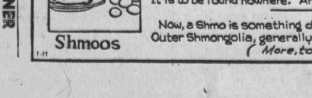
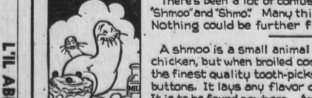
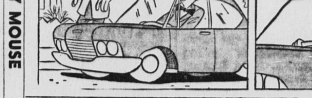
