### CONTRACT BRIDGE

South-West vulnerable.

The bidding:  
South West North East  
1♥ Pass 4♥ Pass  
Opening lead—seven of diamonds.

North's jump bid to four hearts is of pre-emptive nature, describing a hand which is weak defensively but valuable if the opening bidder's suit becomes trump. The high card content for the jump raise to four of a major suit is usually no more than 7 points, but may, as in this case, contain less. It is a defensive measure pure and simple where, frequently, serious doubt exists that the game contract can be made. The purpose is to make it difficult for the adversaries to enter the bidding.

Dealer trumped the opening diamond lead in dummy, played a trump to the king, cashed the ace of clubs and trumped another diamond. The club finesse was then taken and lost. West making the fine defensive return of the queen of spades which led to three spade losers and defeat.

A better method of play is available to South, a method guaranteed to wrap up, seal and deliver the contract. True, it is hidden from view, but a careful search will reveal it.

South should discard a club from dummy on the opening lead, instead of ruffing it. East wins the ace of diamonds and presumably returns a club won by the ace. After one round of trump, declarer cashes the king of clubs and leads the jack.

If West plays the queen on the jack of clubs, South ruffs in dummy, enters his hand with a trump, and on the good ten of clubs discards a spade from dummy, thus restricting his losers to three. If, on the jack of clubs, West plays a low club, a spade is discarded from dummy to obtain the same result.

Of course, it may turn out that East was dealt the club queen. This will not in any way jeopardize the contract because East, on lead, cannot attack the spade king. At best, East can lead a diamond which dummy ruffs. South crosses to his hand and cashes the ten of clubs, discarding another spade. Again there are only three losers.

In short, nothing can defeat the contract if the first trick is sacrificed.

### Forecasts Contents Of Smoking Survey

NEW YORK (AP) — The World-Telegram Sun says in a copy-righted story that the American Cancer Society final report on a survey of smoking habits will "flatly state" there is a relationship between cigaret smoking and death from lung cancer.

The report, ending a four-year study, is not to be issued for several months.

Officials of the cancer society said it is their opinion that the report will offer the conclusions as published by the newspaper.

They explained, however, that previous reports issued by the society offered the same conclusions and that the forthcoming report merely will serve as a survey-ending step.

Some of the points cited by the newspaper:

The lung cancer rate for habitual cigaret smokers — those who smoke about a pack a day — is about 16 times as high as for men who don't smoke at all.

The death rate from all causes, including coronary diseases, is higher among cigaret smokers than non-smokers.

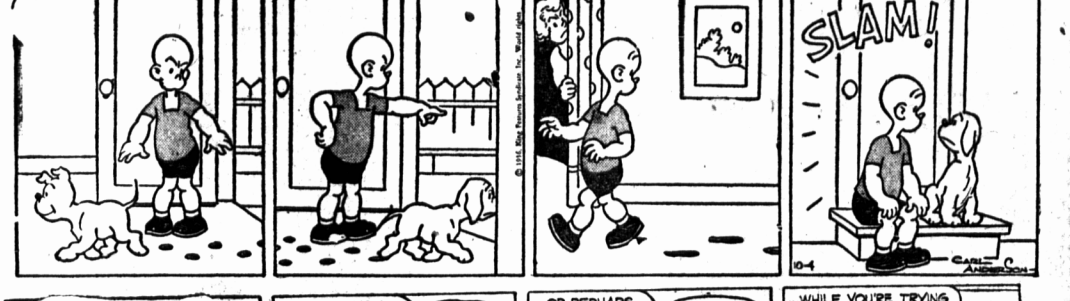
