WINNIPEG, May 13 -- (CP) -- Advances were recorded today in rye futures prices on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange, but some other early gains were erased as offerings increased. Rye upturns were in response to advances in United States rye prices, based on indications of a small rye crop in the U.S. Dry conditions in the American winter wheat belt and in Manitoba also were factors in a moderately active session. A few shipping orders were reported in oats and barley. Some export purchases in barley were believed connected with small sales to the continent. U.S. interests bought rye. There were a few processing orders in flax. Overnight export loadings of Canadian wheat included: Japan 300,000 bushels, Trieste 225,000, Belgium 205,000, Switzerland, 70,000 and Bolivia 70,000.
