Takeover Statement Given On Shawinigan Chemicals
 MONTREAL (CP) — Control of Shawinigan Chemicals Limited was sold to the British American Oil Company to prevent "unknown and possibly incompatible interests" from obtaining control of the firm, a local statement issued by the company said here.
 The statement on the transaction was issued by C. D. Loughrey, president of British American Oil Company and J. A. Fuller, chairman of Shawinigan Water and Power Company.
 Under the agreement, B.A. increases its holdings in Shawinigan Chemicals to 66.23 per cent of the outstanding shares from 25 per cent purchasing \$25,000,000 worth of shares from Shawinigan Water and Power Company.
 Quebec Premier Jean Lesage said that the transaction was done "against the will of the Quebec government and Quebec workers" and that he did not intend to have the power to liquidate the deal because Shawinigan Chemicals has a federal charter.
 The companies statement said the transaction came about because of a proposal by Premier Lesage that the chemical company be incorporated in a new company called Shawinigan Industries Limited.
 Participation was offered by present Shawinigan shareholders at \$3 a share.
