## Montague Man Given High Mark In CD Rescue Course

MONTAGUE — Gilbert Clements, Montague, received the mark of "distinguished" in a rescue course in a recent examination held at Armprior, Ont.

Mayor B. H. Yeo, co-ordinator of the course in the area, received this information yesterday in a letter from O. R. Simpson, civil defence instructor for the province.

To obtain this high mark Mr. Clements had to achieve a mark of 85 per cent or better in oral examinations, practical teaching test, and a written examination.

Statements included on his official report sheet recommended that Mr. Clements who passed the mark of "distinguished" portion of the course, should return for part "C"; that he had a high sense of responsibility; that he was a capable leader and should make a very good rescue instructor and that he was a most interested and eager student, who made excellent progress in all phases of training.

On receiving this report from Mayor Simons, Mayor Yeo stated that the town is very fortunate in having men of this calibre ready to serve this area and expressed the opinion that more residents of the district should take advantage of these courses.

## 94-Year-Old Business Nears End

When W.W. Wallers closes his doors in the near future, it will mark the end of a 94-year old jewelry business which is the latest and oldest on the Island.

The business was first begun by W.W. Wallers in 1868 at a site where the Capital Theatre now stands. Wallers' were in that location for only a year and moved to the present location in 1869. About 1908 or 1909 L.S. Wallers, a son of the founder took over the business. A.W. Wallers, also a co-partner with him. They are the present operators.

When Wallers started in business, the only loss was jewelry, but citizens were added in the late thirties. Henderson and Cudmore have purchased the Waller building and plans for the future are as yet indefinite.

Wallers have for many years been associated with the growth and development of Charlottetown during their colorful 94-year history.

OTTAWA (CP) — Average interest rate of this week's issue of 91-day government treasury bills dropped to 3.08 per cent from 3.21 last week, the Bank of Canada reported Thursday.

The treasury bill rate, generally considered an indicator of conditions in the short-term money market, reversed its week upward climb.

The Bank of Canada's interest rate, which is set at one-quarter of one per cent above the treasury bill rate, fell to 3.32 per cent from 3.46. The bank rate is the minimum charge by the central bank on its infrequent loans to chartered banks.
