**Delay Is Likely In Police Probe**

Winnipeg (CP) — Manitoba Attorney-General Lyon said Thursday he has "no objection" to a postponement of the federal provincial conference on RCMP contracts.

Justice Minister Fulton, who proposed the conference, said Wednesday he hoped to hold it later in the year if the provinces agree.

Attorneys-General of some of the eight provinces leasing RCMP services are called for consideration of the controversial emergency powers amendment clause in the contracts.

Mr. Lyon said Manitoba has "no pressing problems to be discussed at the conference though we are anxious to negotiate the new contract as quickly as possible."
