Shipping Season Opens

The shipping season to Newfoundland was ushered in, so far as this Province is concerned, on Monday, April 20th, when the S. S. "Della" sailed from Charlottetown to Saint John's, Newfoundland with a general cargo of produce including livestock.

Among those taking advantage of this first shipment was the Prince Edward Island Co-operative Livestock Marketing Board, who were filling an order for approximately two hundred sucker pigs. This is the first season in which the Marketing Board has undertaken the export of sucker pigs, and the main purpose in doing so is in order that the little pig marketing may be placed on a sounder basis and in such a way that it may become more profitable to the primary producer.

The Marketing Board has been in communication with Departmental authorities in Newfoundland over a considerable period of time and have been given to understand that in many instances the class of livestock being shipped from this Province was such as would not reflect credit on the producers, and was proving unsatisfactory to the buyers.

The main complaint in connection with the sucker pig trade was that of shipping this stock at too early an age which in a good many instances resulted in a considerable percentage of loss while en-route and thus that on arriving were not in a condition that would encourage enthusiasm in the matter of importations.

From a recent communication we quote the following:

"There are a great many young pigs shipped here every spring, the majority of which I believe are shipped on consignment and in many cases are rather a poor advertisement for Prince Edward Island. At the present time there is a great market each spring for young pigs and it seems a pity that a better stock is not shipped as far as those brought into St. John's area are concerned there is very little loss, but when purchased and shipped to the outposts the loss is quite heavy at times, as a good many of the pigs are too young and weak to stand a three or four day trip by train or boat. If all pigs had to be up to a certain standard before shipment, there would be very little of this trouble."

The emphasis is ours.

The above indicates the trend of thought in the Ancient Colony and should be a guide in the case of future shipments. It can thus be seen that the emphasis placed on equality by the Marketing Board in its recent advertisement for sucker pigs is well founded and its initiation should be persistently adhered to irrespective of who or what the agency may be.

Prince Edward Island can produce quality in every line of farm product that is exported and the application of grading standards applied to stock exported to other outlets should be adhered to with respect to shipments to Newfoundland. It is only by assuring the purchasers that an article of merit can and will be supplied that we can develop a trade with this country consistent with its possibilities.

Mr. P. A. McIsaac, M. L. A. of Souris, remained in the City over the week end in order to assist assembling the stock and getting it underway in proper condition. Mr. McIsaac has had considerable experience in connection with the marketing of different kinds of livestock and he pronounced this shipment of little pigs to be about the finest he had ever seen leaving the Province.

Mr. McIsaac is also a strong believer in co-operative marketing and not only on this occasion, but for many years, has been taking a very active part in encouraging farmers to support their own marketing organizations so that the most profitable market returns might thus be available to the individual shipper.

Further shipments will be undertaken as the season advances and farmers will be well advised to watch the Marketing Board advertisements as they appear in the daily papers.

Michael Dwyer, Minister of Mines in Nova Scotia, has agreed to supply a list of the men to whom the money will be distributed.

Great interest in the fund has been shown by Northern Ontario mining men, Mr. Somerville said, and many large contributions have been received from the district.
