Child's Harelip Poses Problem for Parents

Dear Mary Haworth: Our second son, David, now 6, was born with a double harelip. He has had two repair jobs which turned out very well. He will enter first grade in school next fall.

The other day he was sitting on the back porch with his best friend, Jamie, who is 4 1/2 years old. Jamie asked him: Is that a harelip?

David thought about it, then went to look in a mirror. He came back and told Jamie: "No, I am going a mustache at my age 18, I had successful repair work done."

He had to start wearing glasses last month and some of the children gave him a bad time at first, but he didn't last long. How can we help him grow up to be a well-adjusted human being?

My husband is a military service and we move around quite a bit. We are not sure how very much and accept David as he is. He is a very likeable, friendly child.

What should I say to young children who question me about David's lip? I made the mistake of telling one youngster the truth and found myself involved in a

long explanation. What should I say to adults?

I was born with the same defect and I don't think my parents ever quite got over the shock. My grandfather had a harelip too. He told his children he had fallen and cut his lip.

My father remarked, years ago, that he couldn't understand why God would punish a person that way. Nor does my mother understand why God lets such things happen.

I grew up feeling very self-conscious about my problem until at age 18, I had successful repair work done.

We are a church-going family and teach in Sunday school and pray nightly for God's help in raising our sons. I have read a great deal of material and look forward to your comment.
