

Believes There Will Be No Revival Of Nazism

BONN, Germany, Jan. 21 — (Reuters) — West German Chancellor Konrad Adenauer said Monday German public opinion will prevent any revival of Nazism.

Adenauer's statement was his first official reaction to the British roundup of Nazis last week and the United States high commission's survey published Sunday saying German Nationalism has significantly increased in the last 18 months.

The Chancellor said he is certain that any new party formed along Nazi lines would "suffer a shattering defeat" in the general election due this year.

He said he was profoundly disturbed by the British arrests and criticized the methods used in the U. S. high commission's poll. He said some questions were phrased in a "remarkable manner" and the number of persons questioned, 1,200, was "very few."

"There is no danger that National Socialists of the Hitler model or any other model could come to power in this federal republic," Adenauer said flatly.

The British charged the Nazis, led by Werner Naumann, a former key figure in Joseph Goebbels' Ministry, were infiltrating legitimate right-wing parties. Adenauer said his police had agreed with the British to watch the "Naumann group" and that he was surprised when the arrests were made.

Fritz Heine, press chief for the Social Democrats, the chief opposition party, said the overwhelming majority of Germans reject neo-Nazism.

Adenauer, speaking to correspondents, asked that the importance of recent "Nazi news" should not be exaggerated.

He was concerned about the effect on France, Germany's prospective partner in the defence of Western Europe, where the European Defence Community Treaty and the occupation-ending Bonn conventions face a rough passage in Parliament.

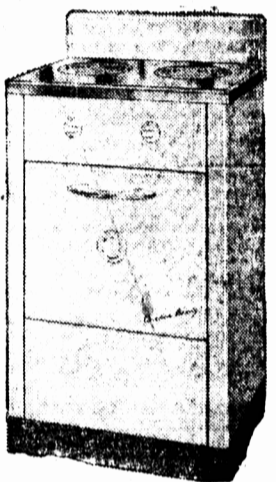
