MONTREAL (CP) — The U.S. dollar closed Monday at a discount of 1 3/16 per cent in terms of Canadian funds, down 1-32. It took 98 13-16 cents Canadian to buy 100 U.S. American. Pound sterling \$2.78 9-16, up 1-16.

N. Y. Stocks

NEW YORK (AP)—The stock market was highly irregular Monday with prices swinging sluggishly.

Changes in individual issues sometimes went as far as 4 points either way in key sections, but most gains and losses were well within a 2-point range.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks was unchanged at \$164.80. The industrial component was up 20 cents while rails were down 20 cents and utilities were unchanged.

Bethlehem Steel rights to buy the new \$191,000,000 offering of 3 1/4 per cent debenture opened on a block of 50,000 at 2 25-32 and closed at 2 13-16.

Canadian issues were mostly lower. Hiram Walker fell 1/2, McIntyre lost 1/2 and Dome Mines dropped 1/2. Distillers Seagram added 1/2 and Canadian Pacific remained unchanged.
