

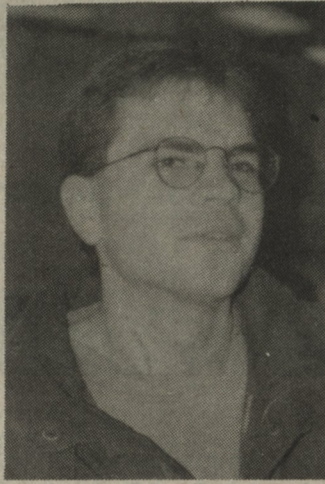
CAMPUS COMMENT
