Under this Federal-Provincial Program approximately 4,400 bursaries will be awarded to Post-Secondary Students to enable them to study one of the official languages during the summer at accredited institutions across Canada. This summer 4,400 young Canadians will have an opportunity to study one of the official languages in immersion courses which are offered at accredited institutions across Canada. The bursaries awarded under the program, which is financed by the federal government and administered by the provinces, are valued at \$610. each and cover the costs of tuition and room and board. They are paid directly to the institution.

To be eligible a candidate must:

- be a Canadian citizen or have landed immigrant status;
- be enrolled as a full-time student during the academic year 1973-74;
- be at least 16 years old by December 31, 1973;
