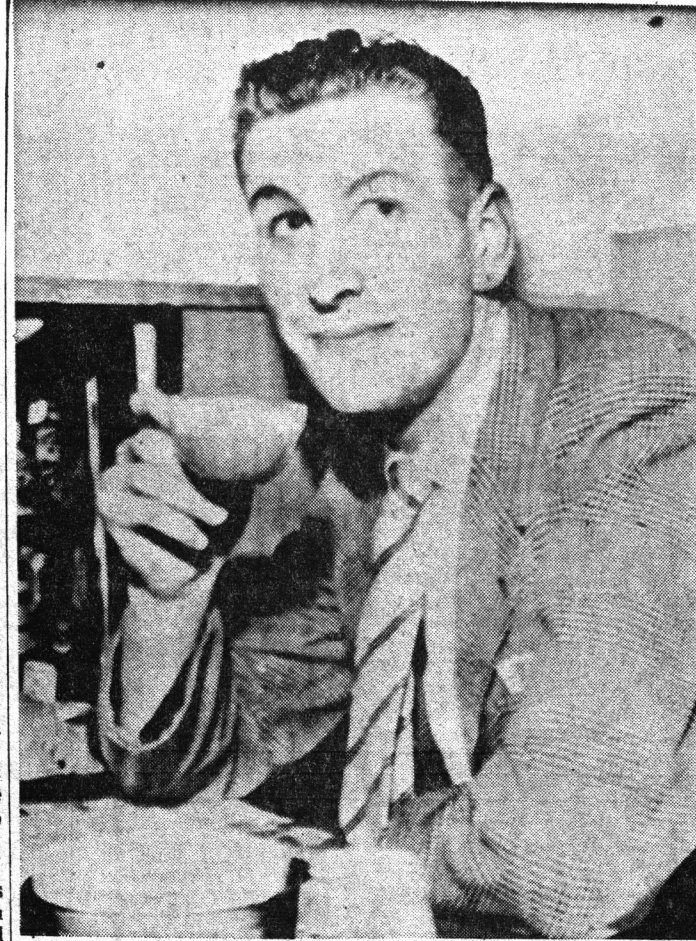

HALIFAX (CP)—Industrial Estates Ltd. will build and lease two new factories to established Nova Scotia boat-building and electronics firms, it was announced Tuesday.

Industry Minister Manson and general manager John B. Essery of Industrial Estates announced jointly that work has begun on a new plant for Weymouth Industries Ltd. in Weymouth. A new factory would be built near Dartmouth for Cossor (Canada) Ltd., an electronics firm operating here since 1948.

"The new plant will enable this company to get back into full production, provide employees with steady work benefit the whole community through the re-establishment of its major industry," the announcement said.
