HIGHLIGHTS OF THE 1957 RACING SEASON AND SOME OF THE PROSPECTS FOR 1958:

- A total of \$1,399,276 was handed by a speculant public across the pari-mutual windows at the suburban Halifax Track. This was almost a \$400,000 increase over the 1956 wager of \$1,016,432.
- More than 90,000 spectators paid their way into the 58 race meets held at the track. In this department, too, a healthy growth was seen. Slightly more than 70,000 had attended in 1956.
- Horsemen received more money. Total purses paid amounted to \$111,450, the highest paid in the Maritimes.
- The three-times-a-week program, started in September of 1957, will be implemented in July of 1958.
- The Maritime Pacing Championship and the Colonel Dan Pace will be made annual events. A Joe O'Brien Pace and a Maritime Trotting Championship are also in prospect for '58.
- A Maritime three-year-old event is planned, called The Hailogian, open to both trotters and pacers. A purse of \$1,000, with added money, will be offered.
