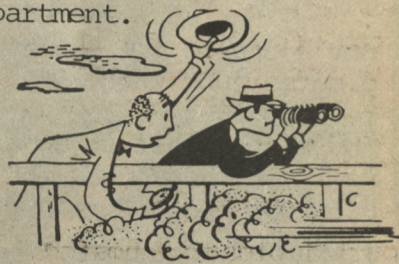

By registering I mean, filling in a new registration form or reviving last year's in person. This being your last year, this registration form should be your best one ever. You may have heard that I have given some sessions on Creative Job Search Techniques. These are sessions on preparing an effective resumé and how to have successful interviews. The Business division has now been completed and we should be seeing some splendid results at recruiting time! Home Economics Department has been scheduled for October 4th for the first session and I will be meeting the Education graduates in mid-November. Now, those of you who do not belong to these faculties have not been left out. My main problem is that you are not all gathered together at the same time for a specific class. So, in the hope of assisting everyone who needs my services, I extend an open invitation to interested BA's and BSc's to come to the office and leave your name. I can then set up sessions for groups of fifteen or so at a time suitable for everyone.

Recruiting time is here and the concept of pre-screening is in. This means the employers ask us to send him/her the applications and resumé of interested students before they come on campus. They then screen these down to what they consider to be a feasible number for them to interview and only those candidates (judged to be the best) are interviewed. This makes the way you present yourself on paper more important than ever. Though it is true most recruiters who come in the fall are interested in Business students, some have agreed to see students of other disciplines who have some business courses or related experience. So please don't screen yourself out - check with us first.

- Due to limited space I will have to end so let me leave you with 'tips to the wise'.
- 1 - Seniors should be registering with us NOW.
  - 2 - Applications for work with the federal government, open to all seniors, must be in by October 11th, 1978.
  - 3 - If you need help in preparing your resumé, it's available right here.
  - 4 - Check our bulletin board regularly - recruiters' names and dates as well as other valuable information is posted there.
  - 5 - Keep in touch.
