NEW YORK, Sept. 15-(AP)—Specialties took the buying play in today's stock market while many of the recent "war baby" sprinters rested at slightly lower levels.

The day's performance consisted of series of moderate dips and rallies. Closing trends were highly irregular in virtually all departments.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks finished up 3 of a point at 52.8. Gains and losses were about evenly divided. Transfers of 1,594,700 shares compared with 2,007,510 the day before and were the smallest for a five-hour session since Aug. 31.

The Canadian Department held firm outside a drop of 1 1-8 points by International Nickel to 41 1-8. Dome, McIntyre, Brazilian and Canadian Marconi marked up fractional gains with other issues unchanged or inactive.

Steel, steadied at the last on forecasts of a further rise in next week's mill operations. A jump of nearly 50 per cent in the week's automotive production over the previous week cushioned falling motors. Expansion in retail spending propped merchandising issues.

Western Union gained 3 3-4 at 35. Up fractions to around 2 were Woolworth, Sears Roebuck, U. S. Steel, Houdaille-Hershey, Lone Star Cement, Youngstown Steel Door, Pullman, American Brake Shoe, Celanese, American Woolen, Allied Chemical, Johns-Manville, Pennsylvania, Southern Railway and Douglas Aircraft.

NEW YORK, Sept. 15-(AP)—Domestic sugar futures fluctuated over a fairly wide range today but the trade generally appeared to be waiting for new developments.

September delivery opened 18 points off on liquidation induced by issuance of 42 notices. After they were stopped the delivery recovered substantially and the active list closed 5 to 7 lower on sales of 22,700 tons.
