Lima has again been visited by an earthquake.

Prince George of Wales is to receive an enthusiastic welcome upon his arrival at Halifax.

The Canadian lacrosse team will leave Belfast for Canada on August 3rd, and disband in Toronto.

England has at her disposal fifty-one well equipped ironclads, the total capacity of which reaches 367,000 tons.

It is highly probable that a professional regatta, lasting three days, will be given on Saratoga lake during the latter part of August.

A 100-yard foot race was arranged lately between Gus Carruthers and John Warrick for \$200 a side, to come in the Montreal Exhibition grounds, on the 2nd of August, between two and three o'clock p. m.

The Sultan of Morocco has had large treasure vaults built 100 feet underground, approached by a subterranean labyrinth guarded by soldiers who, when they enter the service there, never see the light of day again.

The Cunard steamship line have entered into contracts for the construction of two new steamships for their line between New York and Liverpool.

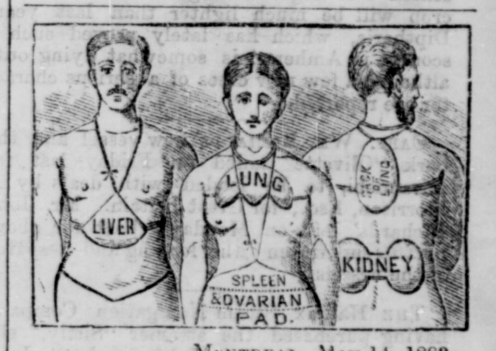
