The Senate Research Committee is now prepared to receive applications for Senate Research Committee grants for the 1980-81 academic year (including this summer). Applications and directions are available for faculty members from their departmental Chairmen and for students from their departmental Chairmen and the Student Union Office. Faculty members are encouraged to call to the attention of qualified students the present opportunity. Note that student research proposals must be recommended by a faculty member who is prepared to act as the

student's research director, and that in the cases of students the official recipient of the grant is the chairman of the academic department involved.
