Chaplin Not Worried Over Possible U. S. Bar

LONDON, Jan. 22 - (AP) - Comedian Charlie Chaplin, facing a possible bar against his re-entry into the U. S., said Wednesday, "Hollywood is going to need me much before I need Hollywood." Still a British subject, Chaplin is living near Corsier, Switzerland. James G. McGranery, then U.S. attorney-general, said recently that Chaplin must convince an examining board he is a fit person to continue working and living in the U. S. before he could be granted permission to re-enter. At London airport Wednesday after arriving from Geneva, Chaplin said that "Hollywood has succumbed to thought control and illegal methods of high-pressure groups, which means the end of the American motion picture industry and its world influence."

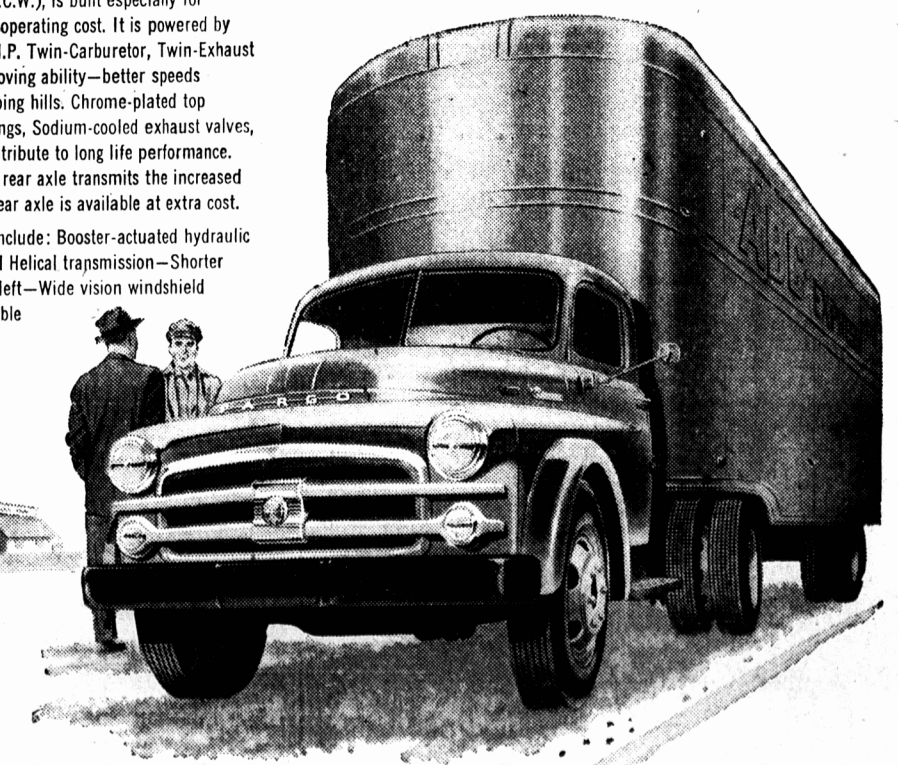
