NEW YORK (AP)—Selective strength in blue chips gave the stock market an irregular advance Friday in listing trading.

The economic atmosphere was clouded by the start of strikes in a number of Ford Motor plants as well as the continuing boom among the car dealers and production.

Ford ended the day with a trifling loss of 1/8 but General Motors and Chrysler also posted fractional losses, making the retreat unanimous for the big three automakers.

This was countered somewhat by the recovery in the market of American Motors, which spiked 1/4 to 1 1/4 on 75,000 shares traded in listing trading.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average advanced 3.35 to 876.87. The Associated Press average of 30 stocks rose to 385.5.

Weakness in rail stocks linked with upcoming wage negotiations in industry which seemed to outweigh the high level of carloadings in the mind of investors.

On the American Exchange Canadian Javelin was up 1/4, Fargo Oil 1/16, United was up 1/4, Scurry Rainbow Oil 1/4.
