

ACETONEMIA

Acetonemia is well known in all raising... It is no respecter of breed, but is more prevalent in producing cows...

Numerous preventative measures and various treatments have been used by as many different individuals with varying degrees of success and failure.

Early attention should be given to cows showing signs of acetonemia. One must remember that there are several forms of this condition and the effective treatments vary to the individual cases.

Preparation for weeds. If producers really knew the influence of weeds in lowering crop values, a greater measure of attention would be paid in the matter of control.

Experiments have been conducted in connection with moisture and fertility diversion, and the lowering of crop yields, and the results of such experiments have indicated an alarming lowering of yield factors.

Fortunately in the past few years the spraying for 2,4-D in grain has become more prevalent, and the results have been outstanding.

In view of the fact that 2,4-D products have been reduced by some manufacturers by about 20 per cent in price, the cost of the material when the subsidy from the Department is paid will bring the average expenditure down to a very low figure.

The total cost, in any event, is very little in comparison with the cost of having these weeds deplete the production and value of the annual crop.

Furthermore the material must be used on the grain crops. No subsidy is paid if it is utilized for any other purpose.

In the case of other cases. This core is at first adherent to the cecal walls. In the worst type of intestinal coccidiosis the small intestine is found to contain a bloody fibrinous exudate.

Only the cecal form occurring in chickens can be positively diagnosed without making a microscopic examination of the cecal or intestinal contents, or lesions from the kidneys of the goose if coccidiosis is suspected.

Coccidial oocysts are exceptionally resistant to most of the common disinfectants and it is difficult, if not impossible to completely free the brooder house of all oocysts when cleaning and disinfecting.

Various methods of treatment with many drugs have been tried, and quite often some of these have proven successful. If anyone has found that a certain treatment has prevented serious losses in his flock year after year, it would not suggest that he change to some other form of medication.

Some of them are safe and effective. No hard and fast rules can be laid down regarding the number of days a flock should be treated with sulfa drugs, and it is advisable before commencing treatment to discuss the situation with someone who thoroughly understands their use.

Another method is to treat with small doses of sulfanilamide or sulfisoxazole intermittently from the time the birds are about four weeks of age until they are past the age when serious outbreaks are likely to occur.

At the time while they are being treated with sulfa drugs, if the drug is administered in the drinking water no other liquids should be given to the birds while they are receiving the treatment.
