

Golden-crowned Kinglet - common in NE PEI from Nov. 10 to 13 (PJ); **Northern Mockingbird** - 1 in Nov. in Abram's Village (GMa), 1 at Lakeside on Dec. 9 (EMa); **European Starling** - 300 at Indian River on Dec. 24 (BG); **Bohemian Waxwing** - 4 flocks (each 20 to 40 birds) along Route 16 between East Point and St. Peters on Nov. 13 in snow storm (PJ), 30 to 40 in Crapaud on Dec. 29 (RA), flock at Rocky Point on Jan. 1 to 3 (LD), 40 to 50 at Kensington on Jan. 2 (RA), 20 at Point Prim on Jan. 7 (DK, JB, LM, SC), 10 at Rice Point on Jan. 3 and 150 at Nine Mile Creek on Jan. 6 (EMa), 100 at Rice Point on Jan. 10 (EMa), 45 at North Rustico on Jan. 20 & 8 on Jan. 26 (DCS); **Cedar Waxwing** - 20 in West Royalty on Dec. 27 (PK), 3 in Queens on Dec. 29 (DCS); **European Starling** - abundant in NE PEI from Nov. 10 to 13 (PJ), at Lakeside on Dec. 9 (DK, JB), 200 at North Rustico on Dec. 9 (DCS); **Yellow Warbler** - 1 on Dec. 11 at Malpeque feeder with flock of Bohemian Waxwings (SH); **Yellow-rumped Warbler** - 1 at Rice Point & 5 at Nine Mile Creek on Dec. 6 (EMa); **Black-and-White Warbler** - 1 at Summerside in trees near feeder on Jan. 2 (SE); **Yellow-breasted Chat** - at Wharf Road in Nine Mile Creek on Oct. 29 (EMa); **American Tree Sparrow** - 1 at Rolfo Bay on Nov. 12 (PJ), 2 near St. Peter's Provincial Park on Dec. 18 (DK, JB, LM), 2 (1 with no tail feathers) at Rocky Point feeder from Dec./01 to Jan./02 (LD), 1 or 2 at North Winsloe feeder on most days in Jan. (GP), 6 at South Rustico on Jan. 13 (EMa, DCS); **Field Sparrow** - 1 at New Dominion feeder on Jan. 17 (EMa) & 18 (DCS); **Vesper Sparrow** - 1 at Springfield (EMa); **Song Sparrow** - uncommon in NE PEI from Nov. 10 to 13 (PJ) with maximum count of 3, 1 at Rocky Point feeder from Dec./01 to Jan./02 (LD), 1 at Cavendish on Feb. 10 (FRC&DL); **White-throated Sparrow** - 1 at East Point on Nov. 11 (PJ), 1 at Lakeside on Dec. 9 (DK, JB), 1 at Crossroads feeder on Jan. 29 (DO); **White-crowned Sparrow** - 1 at Darnley on Sept. 25 (EMa); **Fox Sparrow** - 1 at Crossroads feeder on Nov. 12 (DO), 1 at Nine Mile Creek on Dec. 6 (EMa), 1 at Crossroads feeder on Dec. 30 (DO); **Dark-eyed Junco** - 3 at East Point on Nov. 10 (PJ), 12 at Lakeside on Dec. 9 (DK, JB), 6 at Lakeside on Dec. 18 (DK, JB, LM), 1 at Tyne Valley feeder on Jan. 17 (DMR), 4 to 8 at North Winsloe feeder most days in Jan. (GP), 17 at Crossroads feeder on Jan. 29 (DO); **Lapland Longspur** - 5 at East Point on Nov. 10 (PJ), 2 at Earncliffe on Dec. 30 (DO), 2 at MacInnis Point (east of Earncliffe) on Jan. 21 (DK), 100 at Locke Shore Road in Summerside in Jan. (LH), 40 at Earncliffe on Jan. 27 (DCS); **Snow Bunting** - 20 at New Dominion on Nov. 19 (EMa), two flocks of 50 at East Point Beach & Fortune on Nov. 12 (PJ), 25 at Borden on Nov. 24 (LM), approx. 100 in Kingston on Dec. 19 (JW), 30 at Cablehead & 7 at Campbell's Pond on Jan. 1 (DCS), 12 to 15 at Maplewood Road on Jan. 2 (RA), flock at Point Prim on Jan. 7 (DK, JB, LM, SC), hundreds at New Annan in early Jan. (BH), 30 to 40 at Borden on Jan. 6 (RA), 400 at Earncliffe on Jan. 12 (DCS), 60 on roof top in North Rustico on Jan. 13 (DCS), 200 at North Rustico on Jan. 20 (DCS), 150 at Nine Mile Creek & 25 at Cumberland on Jan. 20 (EMa), 190 at Earncliffe/China Point on Jan. 27 (DCS); **House Sparrow** - common in NE PEI on Nov. 10 to 13 (PJ); **Northern Cardinal** - male at Lakeside on Nov. 24 & 29 (ADM), female at New Glasgow on Nov. 24 (BHoA), female at Bellevue Cove on Dec. 10 (Sve) 1 male at Lakeside on Dec. 6 (ADM), 1 immature male on Dec. 26 until Mid Jan. at Rustico (KLC); **Red-winged Blackbird** - 1 in maples near feeder in Vernon River on Dec. 31 (DK), 18 at Crossroads feeder on Jan. 13 & 14 on Jan. 29 (DO); **Oriole** - reported in Dec. at Connie & Bud Ings (DK); **Common Grackle** - 1 with droopy wing at Rocky Point feeder from Dec. 30 to Jan. 9 (LD), 1 at New Dominion feeder on Jan. 1 (EMa); **Brown-headed Cowbird** - 5 males & 3 females at Crossroads feeder on Nov. 16 (DO); **Pine Grosbeak** - individuals at East Point & Black Pond on Nov. 11 (PJ), 1 male found with gaping mouth at St. Andrew's and it that died shortly after (GG)[an autopsy by Dr. Scott McBurney showed it had a severe fungal lung infection called respiratory aspergillosis], 7 at Macphail's Woods on Nov. 22 (EMa), 3 females at Summerside feeding on High Bush Cranberry on Jan. 5 (SE), 4 at Anglo-Rustico on Jan. 13 (EMa, DCS, DK, et al), 1 at New Dominion feeder on Feb. 15 (EMa); **Purple Finch** - 7 at North Winsloe feeder on Jan. 17 (GP); **White-winged Crossbill** - small flocks flying in, fast and low over the water, from the northeast at East Point on Nov. 10 (Maximum 200) and a few on Nov. 12 (PJ), 20 at Lakeside on Dec. 6 (DK), hundreds flying overhead at Nine Mile Creek on Dec. 6 (EMa), hundreds on the ground, in the trees, and flocks flying about at Stanhope Lane on Dec. 8 (DCS), 20 at Lakeside on Dec. 9 (DK, JB), male & female at Sherwood on Dec. 12 (RoC), tons around Monticello on Dec. 12 (GM), approx. 20 at Hermitage Creek in Dec. (JG), at Rocky Point niger feeders in early Jan. (LD), at New Dominion feeder on Jan. 1 (EMa), 6 to 8 at Indian River on Jan. 5 (BG), male seen at North Rustico feeders on Jan. 7 (KLC), 12+ visiting feeders at Kinross in Jan., up
