

## Maritimers Urge Improved Fishing Harbor Facilities

OTTAWA (CP)—Two Maritimers of opposite political faiths urged the government Tuesday to improve wharfage and harbor facilities for Atlantic coast fishermen.

The pleas came during the Commons throne speech debate from Clement O'Leary (PC—Antigonish-Guyborough) and H. J. Robichaud (L—Gloucester). Mr. O'Leary said those attempting to re-establish themselves in the fishing industry in the two Nova Scotia constituencies of Antigonish and Guyborough found difficulty because of a lack of docking facilities. If they were to be encouraged in their attempt, the government should provide wharves, dredging and breakwaters soon.

**NEED DECISION SOON**  
Mr. Robichaud said that a decision must be made within the next two or three months of replacing and repairing fishing wharves or fishermen would not benefit this year or next.

Dealing with the Maritimes coal situation, he said the industry is suffering from a "depression." It did not seem logical that American coal should be imported to Moncton last year when there was a stockpile of 1,200,000 tons of coal in Nova Scotia. He questioned whether the coal companies were making all possible efforts to sell coal.

Mr. Robichaud reiterated past demands for extension of CBC television coverage in northern New Brunswick, now served by a privately-owned station in Moncton. He said the CBC should put relay stations in northern New Brunswick that would carry the full English-language network service.

A new privately-owned station had been licensed at New Carlisle, Que., but construction had been delayed and the station would not be on the air before next autumn.

**NOT SATISFACTORY**  
The New Carlisle station, across Baie des Chaleurs from New Brunswick, would broadcast 35 per cent of the time in English and the rest in French. This arrangement would be unsatisfactory to either group, each of which had the right to expect from the CBC full service in the two languages.

Mr. O'Leary said that if the government plans to open some sort of federal institution in the mining town of Springhill, N.S., he strongly supports such a move. He apparently referred to reports that the disaster-stricken town is being considered as a site for a penitentiary.

However, Mr. O'Leary said,

substantial industry or employment could not be built up overnight and every effort should be made to find employment for those thrown out of work by closing of the coal pits at Springhill.

**HELP FOR PORT**  
He also urged that help be given the port of Mulgrave, N.S. An engineer and an economist should be sent there to evaluate it as a shipping port, greater publicity should be given its port facilities which were ice-free the year round, dock facilities should be expanded and an ONR spur line should be built to the port from the Canso Causeway three miles away.

These would be particularly important because of the possibility that a \$40,000,000 pulp mill will be built nearby, Mr. O'Leary said. Premier Stanfield of Nova Scotia was negotiating now for the mill.

## Business Is Said Improving

TORONTO (CP)—J. K. Macdonald, president of the Confederation Life Association, said Tuesday that while business conditions are slowly improving, more rapid recovery must await revival of export markets particularly in raw materials.

Speaking at the annual meeting of the company, Mr. Macdonald reported the company had a good year with life insurance protection in force increased by \$164,100,752 to a total of \$2,118,047,766. The company reported net earnings of \$8,340,278 for the year compared with \$6,767,379 in 1957.
