Graduate Studies

PEI Council of Women Bursary:

The PEI Council of Women is offering a bursary at the University of Prince Edward Island.

Two UPEI Alumni Association Scholarships

The UPEI Alumni Association offers the three scholarships mentioned above valued at \$500 each for 1989-90

Following are the terms:

1) Applicants must be full-time students in Senior year at UPEI carrying at least a normal load of five courses per semester and scheduled to graduate in May 1990.

2) The awards will be based on academic performance and financial need.

3) The awards will be for one year only.

4) Applications must be received at the Registrar's Office no later than noon on Friday, 13 October 1989.

(Provincial) IODE Scholarship:

b. The provincial Chapter of the IODE has established a yearly scholarship which is available to an Island student and resident entering Sophomore year at UPEI. It is awarded on the basis of academic achievement and financial need. It is payable to UPEI for the tuition fees for the second semester, beginning in January, 1990. Application forms are available at the Registrar's Office, UPEI Restrictions:

1) Must be resident of PEI (minimum 5 years);

2) Must have been in full-time attendance at UPEI during last year in University;

3) Must be entering Sophomore year; and

4) Must not be on full-tuition scholarship.
