NEW YORK (AP)—The stock market was a study in contrasts Tuesday, great strength alongside weakness, and the result was a scrambled list which went nowhere on average. Trading was heavy.
The Dow Jones industrial average was up only a trifling 61 at 866.51.
The Associated Press average of 60 stocks gained 2 at 355.4 with industrials up 3, rails up 1 to a 1965 high and utilities off 7.
Among Canadians, International Nickel gained 1/2, and Hudson Bay Mining and McEwen Porcupine each dropped 1/4. Canadian Pacific and Dome Mines dropped 1/4 and Aluminum Ltd. and Granby Mining were down 1/4.
Prices on the American Stock Exchange were irregularly lower. Canadian eavlin lower. Canadian Javelin and Molybdenite were up 1/4 and Brazilian Traction dropped 1/4. Scurry Rainbow Oil was down 1/4.

MONTREAL (CP)—Losses and gains were almost equally balanced in quiet trading Tuesday on the Montreal and Canadian stock exchanges.
The composite index dropped 0.01 to 159.05.
Industrials rose 0.04 to 165.24. Moore Corp. was up 1/2 at 52.
Utilities added 0.15 to 155.25.
Fraser rose 1/2 to 30. Dominion and Great Lakes each added 1/4 to 18 1/4 and 22 1/4 respectively.
Banks fell 0.61 to 120.64. Nova Scotia down 1/4 to 72 and Montreal 1/4 to 60 1/4. Imperial Commerce was off 1/4 at 62 1/4.
Papers were off 0.29 at 116.74. MacMillan Bloedel and Powell River dropped 1/4 to 26 1/4 and 41 1/4 respectively.
Metals were mixed. In the base section Hollinger added 1/4 to 27 1/4 and International Nickel 1/4 to 10 1/4. Among primary issues Canada Iron fell 1/2 points to 61 1/4 and Algoma 1/2 to 61.

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TORONTO

TORONTO (CP)—Prices were mixed in moderate trading on the Toronto Stock Exchange Tuesday with base metals the only group creating any excitement.
The metal index climbed 15 to 86.84 after wallowing on the minus side for most of the day.
Pine Point, which has a vast lead-zinc orebody in the Northwest Territories, attracted some attention, gaining 1 1/2 to 81 1/4. Its parent company, Cominco, was up 1/2 to 51 1/4.
Senior coppers were mostly lower with Noranda off 1/4 to 53 1/4 and Hudon Bay 1/4 to 77 1/4. Among uranium, Rio Algom fell 1/4 to 19 1/4.
Canada Iron declined 1 to 62 to lead industrial lower. Imperial Bank of Commerce gave up 1/2 at 62 1/4 as did MacMillan, Bloedel at 25 1/4. Canadian Breweries eased 1/4 to 7 1/4.
Some key issues found support with gains of 1/4 recorded by Moore Corp. at 81 1/4, Walkley Sugar at 25 1/4 and Atlantic Gooderham at 36 1/4.
On index, industrials were down .07 to 169.54, golds .11 at 158.26 and the TSE index .04 at 159.84. Western oils gained 11 to 103.57.
