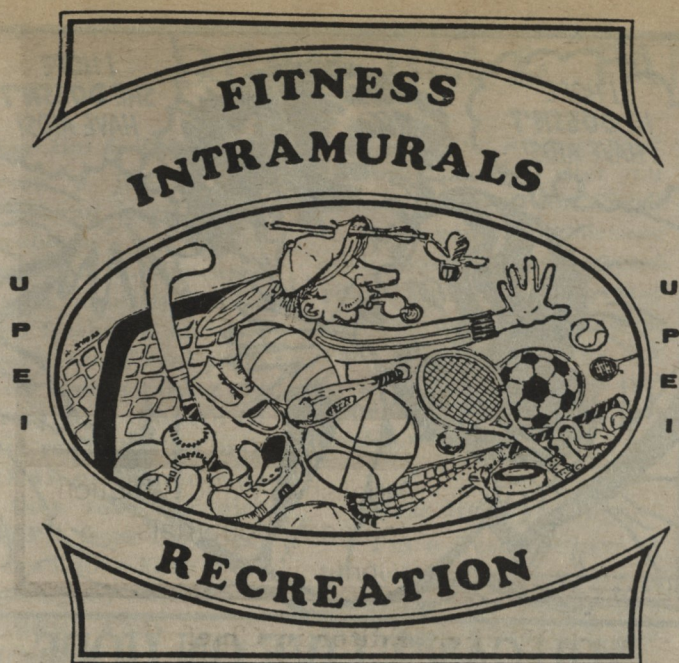

On Saturday the Soccer Panthers ran into a very hot University of New Brunswick Redshirt squad who are presently in first place in AUAA West division. David Foley scored both goals for UNB in the first half. Sandwiched between Foley's two goals was a goal by Richard Pierre-Giles on a penalty kick.
