NEW YORK

NEW YORK (AP) - The stock market mounted a recovery late Monday but wasn't able to overcome early losses.

Prices fell from the start, reached their lowest level at mid-day and then started coming back.

Brokers indicated that investors' cautiousness was due in part to problems in the steel, automobile and construction industries. Steel has reported that sales to automakers are declining, the automobile industry has reported lower sales and housing starts have sunk to their lowest level in many years.

Steels, motors, aircrafts and building materials declined. Chemicals, nonferrous metals, utilities and airlines advanced.

The Dow Jones average of 30

declined 2.18 to 801.16 after having been down 4.74 at one stage. The Associated Press 60-stock average fell 4 to 293.9 with industrials off 1.2, rails off .1 and utilities up .3. Of 1,439 issues traded, 625 declined and 372 advanced. There were 32 new 1966 lows and 14 new highs.

Dome Mines gained 1 1/4 in Canadians. Distillers Seagrams gained 1/2. International Nickel 3/4 and McIntyre Porcupine 1/4. Canadian Pacific lost 1/4. Hudson Bay Mining 1/4. Alcan and Massey 1/4 and Walker Gooderham 1/4.

Prices were mixed on the American exchange. Scurry rainbow oil lost 1/4 and Canadian-Javelin and Jupiter Corp. 1/4.

MONTREAL

MONTREAL (CP) - A handful of favored issues made strong showings Monday on the Montreal Stock Exchange while the main body of stocks marked time.

The 85-stock composite index advanced .02 to 138.40, indicating little change in the blue chip issues, while total declines outnumbered advances 80-70 in light trading.

Moore Corp. was the best performer, rising 2 1/2 points to 87 1/4. Great Lakes Paper was up 1 1/4 points at 24 1/4 and Interprovincial Pipe Line one point at 83.

There were no areas of pronounced strength or weakness in the market although the oils in general were somewhat firmer and the industrials managed to hold their own.

SENIOR MINES HALT DECLINE Senior mines halted their general decline.

Among senior oils B-A advanced 1/4 to 30 1/4 and Pacific Pete 1/4 to 11 1/4.

Canadian Breweries was the most active industrial, unchanged at 6 1/4 on a turnover of 15,670 shares.

Utilities were off with declines of 1/4 posted by Maritime Telephone at 22 1/4, Newfoundland Light at 9 1/4 and Quebec Natural Gas at 19. Brinco fell five cents to \$4.05.

Prices were slightly higher on the Canadian Stock Exchange. Alscope climbed 16 cents to \$2.25.

On index, utilities fell 1/4 to 127.85, banks 18 to 109.53, and papers .50 to 107.18. Industrials were up .08 at 145.07.
