WILL BE WIPE OF THE EARTH. Winthrop, Mo., Has Literally Melted Into the River as a Result of Floods.

It is said that, as a direct result of the high water in the Missouri river, which will no begin to recede for some time, the once prosperous village of Winthrop, 60 miles south of St. Joseph, on the Rock Island Railroad, has been completely obliterated. The Missouri river, which flows from the Pacific to Kansas City, St. Joe & Council Bluffs railroads, will soon be wiped off the earth.

The Missouri river when it first began its spring run this year began cutting the bank at the edge of the town and adjacent to it, and to-day half of the place has melted into the river, together with half a dozen of its principal stores.

Winthrop, which was a town of 15,000 people, has already lost half of its population, and as the houses cannot be sold they are being torn down and carried into the country.

The work of demolishing the Methodist Church, a structure which cost \$10,000 a year ago, is now going on, it having been sold to a farmer for \$50. He will use its material to make a farm. Farmers in this section are valued at \$500 and \$1,000 two months ago are without an acre of ground to-day.

THE SAILORS FAVOR THEM. The Four Amendments to the United States Marine Laws Before Congress.

Every union seaman who has landed at Boston within the past month has affixed his signature to a lengthy petition to Congress asking that the four amendments to the marine laws be adopted as proposed by Representative McGuire of California. The petition will be forwarded to Washington in a few days. The principal changes called for in the McGuire bill are as follows: Abolition of the voluntary servitude; twelve hours to be a regular day's work; payment of one quarter of the amount of wages due whenever in port; payment of one quarter of the amount of wages due when discharged, balance to be paid within forty-eight hours; privilege of having vessels surveyed; improved regulations governing the sanitary arrangements of vessels and the condition of food. Consuls of different countries are quoted, showing what privileges their sailors enjoy. The petition was endorsed by the Boston Central Union today.

The amendments are bitterly opposed by owners of vessels, and the Marine Exchange of New York has declared war against them.

Notice to Commercial Travellers. The attention of Commercial Travellers is called to the following sections of an Act passed by the Legislative Assembly of Prince Edward Island, on the 21st day of May, 1894, entitled "An Act to Impose a Direct Tax on Certain Classes of Travellers."

1. "From and after the passing of this Act every casual trader not permanently residing in this Province doing business within this Province, commonly known as 'Commercial Travellers,' and every person not permanently residing in this Province, and who sells either for himself or any other person any goods, wares or merchandise in this Province, or solicits or canvasses for orders either for the sale, exchange or purchase of any goods, wares or merchandise within this Province, either by the production of samples, photographs, catalogues, printed or written matter, or by word of mouth without the production of samples, photographs, catalogues, printed or written matter, shall, before he or she enters upon the business of so soliciting or canvassing for such orders, pay to the Provincial Treasurer of this Province an annual license fee or direct tax of fifty dollars."

"Upon payment of the said license fee or direct tax, the said Provincial Treasurer shall grant a license authorizing the person therein named to sell goods, wares and merchandise in this Province, and to solicit and canvass for orders for the sale, exchange or purchase of any goods, wares or merchandise in this Province, for the space of one year following the date upon which the said license shall be granted and no longer."

"Any such Commercial Traveller who does not permanently residing in this Province, and who, after the passing of this Act, shall sell any goods, wares or merchandise, or solicit or canvass for orders for the sale, exchange or purchase of any goods, wares or merchandise in any manner aforesaid within this Province, without having first paid the said license fee or direct tax, and obtained the said license, shall be liable to pay the sum of two hundred dollars to the said Provincial Treasurer."

A HALIFAX FIRE FIGHT. It Occurred in the Police Court and Resulted in Both Being Locked Up. A most disgraceful and unprecedented affair occurred in the police court at Halifax, on Tuesday. Alderman W. O'Donnell was giving evidence in an ordinary assault case, when John T. Balmer, defendant's counsel, entered a vigorous protest against the witness also being allowed to make any statement in the exchange of epithets. Ald. O'Donnell jumped out of the witness box rushed to the counsel table and punched the lawyer's head. Judge Moton was paralyzed and gazed in stolid stupidity at the disgraceful scene. Following the Alderman's attack on the lawyer, William F. McCoy, Q. C., reentered of the city and deputy judge of the court, made some scolding allusion to the conduct of the witness. This was responded to, whereupon the deputy judge grabbed a big walking stick and made a dive at the lawyer. Tremendous excitement prevailed. The prisoners strolled out of the dock and mixed with the audience, but were too much interested in the fight to make their escape. Finally the court and the police recovered themselves and arrested lawyer Balmer for abusive and insulting language to Ald. O'Donnell and Recorder McCoy. Notice to Commercial Travellers. The attention of Commercial Travellers is called to the following sections of an Act passed by the Legislative Assembly of Prince Edward Island, on the 21st day of May, 1894, entitled "An Act to Impose a Direct Tax on Certain Classes of Travellers."

1. "From and after the passing of this Act every casual trader not permanently residing in this Province doing business within this Province, commonly known as 'Commercial Travellers,' and every person not permanently residing in this Province, and who sells either for himself or any other person any goods, wares or merchandise in this Province, or solicits or canvasses for orders either for the sale, exchange or purchase of any goods, wares or merchandise within this Province, either by the production of samples, photographs, catalogues, printed or written matter, or by word of mouth without the production of samples, photographs, catalogues, printed or written matter, shall, before he or she enters upon the business of so soliciting or canvassing for such orders, pay to the Provincial Treasurer of this Province an annual license fee or direct tax of fifty dollars."

"Upon payment of the said license fee or direct tax, the said Provincial Treasurer shall grant a license authorizing the person therein named to sell goods, wares and merchandise in this Province, and to solicit and canvass for orders for the sale, exchange or purchase of any goods, wares or merchandise in this Province, for the space of one year following the date upon which the said license shall be granted and no longer."

"Any such Commercial Traveller who does not permanently residing in this Province, and who, after the passing of this Act, shall sell any goods, wares or merchandise, or solicit or canvass for orders for the sale, exchange or purchase of any goods, wares or merchandise in any manner aforesaid within this Province, without having first paid the said license fee or direct tax, and obtained the said license, shall be liable to pay the sum of two hundred dollars to the said Provincial Treasurer."
