South African Situation.

CAPE TOWN, July 15.—An attempt to hold a loyalist meeting at Worcester yesterday afternoon was frustrated by the Afrikaners, who pre-empted the disgraceful scene, forcibly dragged the loyalist speakers from the platform and expelling them from the hall amid jeers and insults. It is reported that several Dutch members of the Legislature participated. The publication of the text of the Transvaal franchise law, now being debated at Pretoria, has accentuated the bitterness between the two elements. The military authorities here are purchasing horses, mules and waggons, and preparing to forward supplies to Kimberley.

Philippine Situation

MONTREAL, July 15.—B. William Robertson, a prominent English resident of Manila, who has arrived in Montreal from that city, gives some interesting facts regarding the present situation in the Philippines:—

"Aguinaldo," says Mr. Robertson, "is remorseful. His influence is waning and he often sits down and cries over the miserable condition into which he has placed his people. There is great dissension in his army. Friendly Filipinos have been the medium of communication between the American authorities and the military leaders of the insurrection in Cavite with a view of a peaceful settlement, but to this Aguinaldo will not agree, he saying that having sworn to support the insurrection he must remain to the end. Bands have gone out for plunder, and are willing to murder. They are as dangerous to their leader as they are to the Americans. The bandits are the men with whom the United States will have to deal, and in order to keep them down it will be necessary to maintain a large army in the field, to remain until the thieves are either captured or killed."

"The whole controversy, which has already cost so many lives, has in brief," Mr. Robertson said, "narrowed itself down to this question. It is not whether the United States shall let the Filipinos govern themselves, but whether it shall allow a small portion to misgovern all the rest. It has no more right to abandon the islands and their occupants to savage or semi-savage misrule than Admiral Dewey had to scuttle his ships in Manila bay. As truce it cannot resign."

The Late Czarwitch.

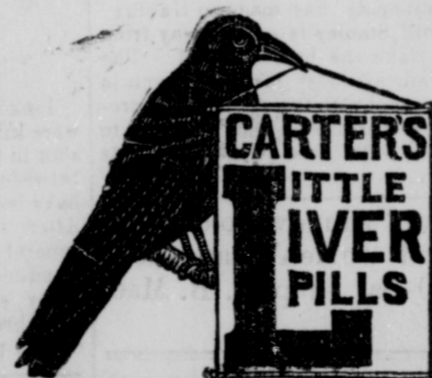
ODessa, July 15.—Four ironclad and a flotilla of torpedo boats have gone to Batoum to convey the remains of the Czarwitch to Sebastopol.
