UPEI had built up a 3-1 lead with goals by Ann Campbell and Peggy MacAdam only to see Moncton close the gap to within one with less than three minutes to play. Panther goalie Theresa Gallant and the defense pairs of Andree Campbell, Cathy Hendricken, and Mary Morrison-Janis Morrison however didn't allow Moncton the equalizer.

In the round robin play on Saturday UPEI defeated the Nova Scotia representatives, Dalhousie University of Halifax by a 3-1 score. They also lost a very close, physical checking game to the same Moncton Jaguars, by an identical 3-1 score. Goal scorers in those games were Anne Campbell with

two, Rose Whalen and Andree Campbell. Patti Bradley had two strong games in net to allow the Panthers to go on to the final.

This win on the weekend caps a very successful season for the Lady Panthers as they improved their mark in tournament play to a perfect two for two. Back in January the girls also won the Maritimes top tournament, the UNB Invitational. These two tournament wins will more than likely ensure UPEI its continued ranking as the top womens team in the Maritimes. They have enjoyed this top spot since last January.

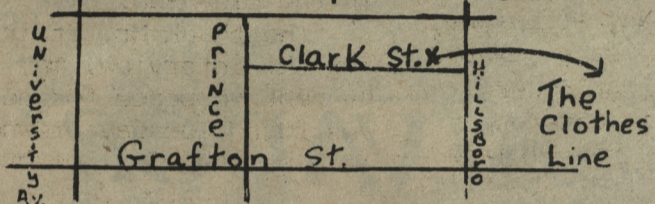
