Opening lead—two of spades.

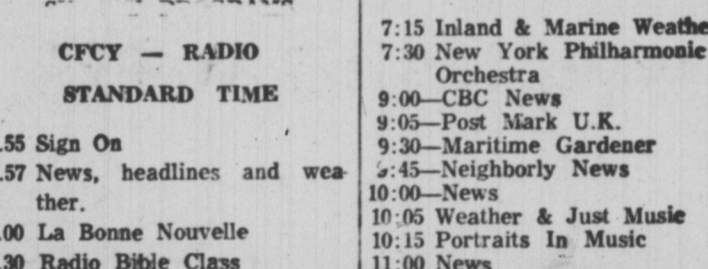
This hand was played in a 13-table match point duplicate game. The deal was remarkable in that a different result was obtained at nearly every table, even though exactly the same cards were in play at each table.

Where North-South bought the hand, the final contract was either four, five, or six hearts, or five or six clubs. In some cases the contract was doubled.

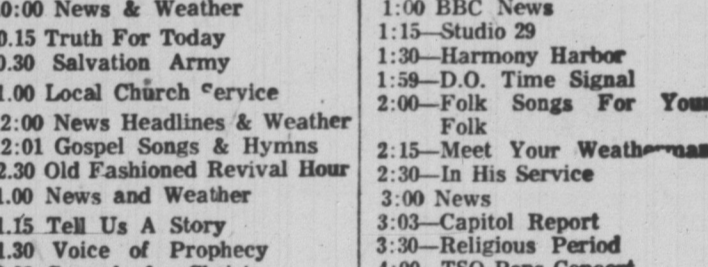
Where East-West bought the contract, they played in five or six spades, doubled in every case.

The North-South pairs who bid and made a slam in hearts or clubs obtained the best scores in their direction. The East-West

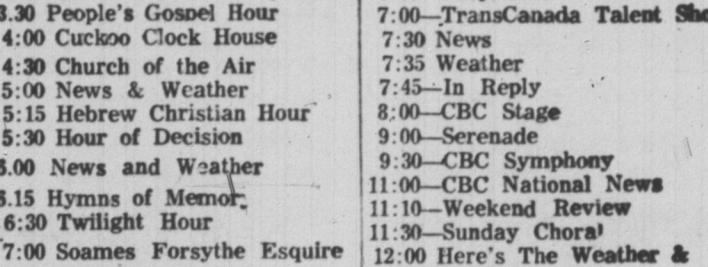
