MONTREAL (CP) — The U.S. dollar closed Friday at a discount of 2-1/2 per cent in terms of Canadian funds, down 1-3/4. Pound sterling \$2.72 1/2, unchanged.

Toronto Stocks

TORONTO (CP) — The stock market recorded a mild decline Friday in a listless and uninteresting session. The western oil index lost more than a point as base metals dipped more than one-half point.

Brokers said they expect the market to remain in the slow, irregular tone until the political conventions in the United States are over.

Senior base metals were lower with Hudson Bay, Noranda and Falconbridge off fractionally. Labrador advanced 1/4. Cassiar gained 25 cents in juniors while Nipissing, Silver-Miller and Belcher advanced 10-15 cents. Iron Bay Mines lost 20 cents. Mogul 15 cents and Consolidated Regout 14 cents.

Coppers were stronger with Campbell Chibougamau ahead 1 1/2 points, Chibougamau sheet added 25 cents. New Royan 20 cents and Copper Cliff 15 cents. Franco Pacific uranium higher with a 25-cent gain. Other winners included Northspan, Milliken Lake, Gunnar, Consolidated Denison and Biorct.

Interest in western oils was at its lowest in many sessions with only a few stocks recording sizeable price changes. Crown Oil jumped 55 cents and Dome Explorations (Western) and Canada Oil Lands 15 cents. General Pet 15 cents and Canadian Atlantic lost 15 cents.

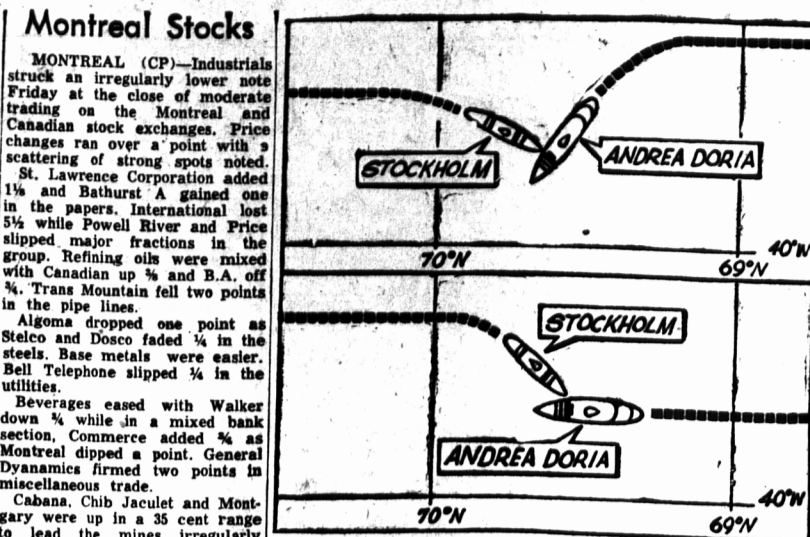

N. Y. STOCKS

NEW YORK (AP) — A promising stock market rally fizzled into irregularity Friday on dwindling volume. Sales of 1,720,000 shares were the lowest since July 2 and compared with 1,790,000 Thursday.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks dipped 20 cents to \$188.60. Glen L. Martin gained 1 1/2 to 32 1/2 on 32,500 shares to head the New York stock exchange. Active was General Public Service, up 1/4 at 27.80 on 27,800 shares. Third was Studebaker - Packard, off 1/4 at 7 on 27,800 shares.

Next came Jones and Laughlin, up 1/4 at 56 1/2 and Canadian Pacific, up 1/4 at 36 1/4. Long Bell Lumber led 4 1/2 and International Paper 3 1/2 as directors approved merger plans. Among Canadian issues on the New York stock exchange, Aluminium Ltd. was ahead 1/4. International Nickel slipped 1/4 to 4 1/2 and Walker-Gooderham was down 1/4.

On the American stock exchange Jupiter Oils gained 1-1/2. Other Canadian oil issues slipped minor fractions or were unchanged. In industrial Shawinigan led 1/4 and Canadian Marine 1/4. Brazilian Tractor was changed.
