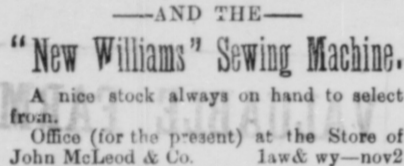

4th. If possible to talk and be heard when standing back two or three feet from the transmitter, if you should talk enough, but it is not a pleasant mode of conversation, is entirely unnecessary, and is a useless waste of wind and lungs, besides being very annoying to all within range of your voice.
