

# Scholarships & bursaries

## EMBASSY OF ITALY

The Government of Italy offers scholarships to Canadian students for enrolment in Italian Universities or for individual studies in Italy. The scholarships are to be used during the academic year from November 1, 1978 to October 31, 1979 and may be awarded for periods of 1 to 9 months. Valued at 240.00 Italian lire per month, plus life and medical insurance for the scholar-ship's duration. DEADLINE IS APRIL 30.

## NATIONAL INSTITUTE ON MENTAL RETARDATION (TYPE B - SUPPLEMENTARY FUNDING)

Research Study Supplements to students enrolled in graduate studies at a Canadian university and planning a career directly in the field of mental retardation, or an associated professional field. Valued at \$1,000 per year for two years. In addition to the financial support, the award provides

the opportunity for attendance at a one-week period of orientation training at the National Institute on Mental Retardation with prepaid tuition, training and living costs. DEADLINE IS APRIL 14.

## S.R. LAYCOCK BURSARY

The bursary will be made on the understanding that the recipient accepts employment in Canada upon completion of his or her studies in the field of HEALTH EDUCATION. Valued at \$500. DEADLINE IS APRIL 30.

## THE UNIVERSITY OF VICTORIA (FACULTY OF LAW)

Three scholarships in the amount of \$3,500 each, are available for students entering the September 1978 academic year of the course leading to the Bachelor of Laws degree at the University of Victoria. DEADLINE IS MARCH 31.
