

COOL WEATHER IS FORECAST

Above-normal temperatures are indicated for the Prairies in the 30-day weather outlook by the United States weather bureau for mid-May to mid-June. However, both east and west coasts are expected to have unseasonably cool weather and the west coast will be wetter than usual. The outlook is not a specific forecast and changes may occur. Tail Lights Are Debated

OTTAWA (CP) — A proposal that green tail lights be made a compulsory addition to motor vehicles drew mixed reaction Tuesday from delegates to the annual Ontario traffic conference.

Insp. Ernest W. Duffield of the Sarnia police department said the proposal was aimed at speeding more time to adjust when the red brake light flashed on indicating a stop.

He told delegates from police departments and traffic and parking authorities across the province that the present system of red lights on the back of vehicles is confusing. The red light now serves the three functions: tail light, brake light and turn signal.

If a driver took his eye off the road at the moment the driver ahead braked, the only thing to notify the driver behind would be the greater brilliance of the red light.

DRAW ATTENTION

But if the tail light were green, application of the red brake light would be quickly noticed.

This principle had been applied with success to front signals whose amber color made them easily distinguishable from the white headlights. Amber turn signals should be used on the back of vehicles as well.

Several delegates spoke from the floor in opposition to the proposal, claiming green has traditionally indicated all clear ahead and a driver could not give this assurance to drivers following him.

Insp. Duffield said tests conducted by optometrists indicated green is easily perceived by the eye.

Hockey Said Outside Scope Of Council

OTTAWA (CP) — Hockey is not considered as part of the arts, humanities or social sciences by the Canada Council, the Commons public accounts committee was told Tuesday.

James Muir (PC-Lisgar) inquired about hockey's standing with the government agency established to foster art in the nation as the committee considered the 1965 spending program of the Canada Council.

Council chairman Jean Martineau replied that hockey and other sports are "outside our jurisdiction." They don't rate as art forms.

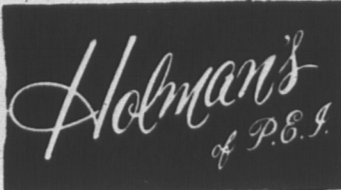
