

### Bear River Woman Is Still Missing

**SOURIS** — Mrs. Joseph MacCormack of Bear River has been reported missing from her home. She was last seen at 10 a.m. July 1.

She is described as 23 years of age, with dark hair, five feet, nine inches tall, weighing 140 pounds, and wearing a white coat, white slacks and sandals.

Police are asking anyone knowing the whereabouts of Mrs. MacCormack to contact the nearest RCMP detachment.

### Youth Fined For Throwing Firecrackers

Vincent McGarry of Inna was fined \$20 and costs for 10 days for disorderly conduct—throwing firecrackers on parked cars—in city police court Saturday.

The youth told Magistrate A. J. Haslam, Q.C. he had only one firecracker in his possession.

Linus J. MacQuillon, Bonshaw, was fined \$125 and costs or 30 days for impaired driving.

Cyril MacLeod, Charlottetown, was fined \$15 and costs or five days for speeding, and Harry R. Craig, Victoria, was fined \$10 and costs or five days for failing to stop at a red traffic light.

The case of Donald George Jay, East Royalty, was adjourned to July 7 following testimony of Sgt. Keith Wakelin, city police. Jay pleaded not guilty to a charge of driving without due care and attention.

On a similar charge, Clarence Wood had his case adjourned to July 10.

The case of Richard McGee, Charlottetown, charged with failing to yield the right of way, was also adjourned to July 10.

There were 13 cases of drunk and incapable on the docket. Four were given 20-day suspended sentences (one on condition he leave town this morning), four were fined \$20 and costs or 30 days; three were fined \$10 and costs or five days; one was remanded to July 5, and one was sentenced to 20 days in Queens County jail.

He left with his family Saturday for his annual leave prior to starting his retirement leave. He will spend a brief holiday with his mother, in Lunenburg, N.S., where he was born in 1915, a son of Mrs. Chipman and the late John Chipman.

Following this he is heading for British Columbia where he will probably make his future home.

He came to this province in 1960 and has served at Borden and Alberton as well as in the city where he has been in charge of the Charlottetown Detachment, in charge of the Orderly Room, and since February of last year the sergeant major. Prior to coming here he had served in a large number of towns and cities in New Brunswick.
