

Education Committee Announced

Consultative committee on Education announced - March 14, 1990.

On March 14, 1990, - Minister of Education Paul Connolly announced the formation of the Provincial Consultative Committee in Education.

"The Education system involves many partners who play

distinctly different roles in the educational process," said Mr. Connolly. "Consultation and good communications are vital to the success of this complex organization."

Mr. Connolly stated that the Provincial Consultative Committee on Education would provide an essential opportunity for

discussion on important concerns of the educational community. "I will be using the committee to provide comments in subjects such as legislation, regulations, policies, and significant issues concerning the public education system," said Mr. Connolly.

Membership on the new committee will be drawn from the de-

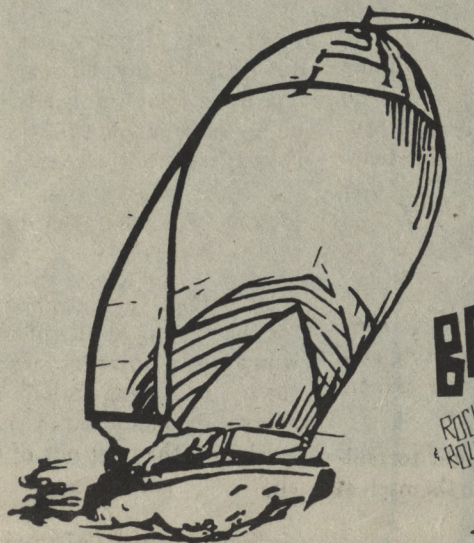
partment of education, Regional School

Units, Teacher's Federation, the PEI School Trustees' Association, the Home and School Association, and the Faculty of Education at UPEI. In addition, there will be representatives from others such as the Business Community, the Advisory Council on the

Status of Women, and the Comite Acadien.

The consultative committee will meet at least two time a year and will be chaired by the Minister of Education. The minister stressed that it was intended to supplement, but not replace, the existing consultation mechanisms between the minister and the partners in the education system.

"As minister, I must rely upon the informed comments and advice of the partners in education to guide me," stated Mr. Connolly. "That requires that the partners have both the means and the opportunities to provide significant input into the decision making process. This committee provides one way to do that."

The Rubber Band Effect Revisited

An astounding breakthrough in time travel was announced today at MIT. The time travel theorem known as the Rubber Band Effect took another step towards becoming economically feasible.

Scientists at MIT have found the answer to one of the problems preventing wide-spread use of the Rubber Band Effect: the prohibitive cost of constructing a suitable rubber band.

Ever since the Rubber Band Theorem was proposed by a research team at UPEI last year known only as the Ghost Writers, efforts to construct a suitable rubber band have revolved around the use of rubber in the making of the band.

But now, an MIT research team working on the same problem has come up with something that may just earn them the Nobel Prize.
