

### Emil Zatopak Quits Sports

BERLIN (AP)—Emil Zatopak, star Czech runner, is retiring from active sports, the official East German news agency ADN reported Wednesday.

ADN said Zatopak announced in Moscow that he plans to retire. Zatopak participated in the recent Olympic Games in Melbourne, Australia, and was en route home to Czechoslovakia.

Zatopak, 34, underwent an operation for a rupture last summer and did not recover his old record-winning form. The Czech army officer won three gold medals in the 1952 Olympics.

MILWAUKEE (AP)—Milwaukee Braves Wednesday announced the signing of 29-year-old Carl Sawatski, a catcher who batted .300 for Toronto Maple Leafs in the International League last season. Sawatski, who was purchased from the Toronto club last fall.

### Chris Brasher Quits Track

LONDON (AP)—Chris Brasher of Britain, winner of the Olympic Games 3,000-metre steeplechase, arrived Wednesday via New York and immediately announced his retirement from track competition.

"In the future I shall only run for recreation to stop me puffing when running for a bus," he said.

"But I like skiing and it may be that I can get into British cross-country skiing team for the winter Olympics at Squaw Valley, Calif., in 1960," he said.

### Carl Furillo Signs With Brooklyn

BROOKLYN (AP)—Carl Furillo joined captain Pee Wee Reese, Don Newcombe, Duke Snider and four lesser lights in the Brooklyn Dodgers Wednesday when he signed his 1957 contract calling for a reported \$27,500 the safe salary he received last year.

The strong-armed outfielder, now 34, batted .289 in 1956, hitting 21 home runs. He is one of the few active players with a lifetime .300 batting average in 11 seasons with the Dodgers.

We have received a copy of the 1956 Harness Racing Review for Truro Raceway, by Ingham Palmer. This review is for Truro Raceway only and reflects great credit on friend Ingham, whose splendid announcing is a feature of the night racing programs there. In the compilation of leading drivers with more than 75 starts, George Turner of Dartmouth is tops with 23 starts, 22 seconds and 23 thirds. Clayton MacLeod of Wentville follows with 34 firsts, 20 seconds and 23 thirds and Johnny Conroy is next with 21 firsts, 7 seconds and 11 thirds. Ed Haley is fourth, Harley Harrison fifth and Frank Dankeis sixth. In the second division with less than 75 starts and more than 25, George Mauger is out in front with Don Turner second, Gerry Nelson third, Charlie Connors fourth and Cyril Smith fifth.

Clayton MacLeod is leading race winner with 34 firsts. George Turner is the driver with the most Johnny Conroy 21 firsts, Don Turner is the driver with the most 2:10 miles - 7, George Mauger 3, Harley Harrison 2, Lorne Letcher 2 and Clayton MacLeod 1. George Turner's Maritime bred trotter, Pepper Boy won more races at the Truro Raceway than any horse this season - 12. He was owned by Heber Sweeney, Bridgewater and driven by R. McAdulf.

In our Maritime Harness Racing Review for 1956 we were in error in crediting Singing Sword as the holder of the track trotting record at Sackville Downs Raceway. It should have been credited to New-Port Express 2:04 2-5. His trip was in 2:10 3-5. He was owned by Heber Sweeney, Bridgewater and driven by R. McAdulf.

Through the combined efforts of Truro Raceway, Ltd. and the Truro Horsemen's Club a total of 42 racing programs were given, 38 by the Raceway and 6 by the Club. For 1957 it is hoped that more than 50 meets will be presented over the Bible Hill course. In the 36 meets between 140 and 150 horses faced the starter. The total attendance figure is estimated at 30,000 and approximately \$600,000 was taken through the mutuels. The biggest turnout was the night of the Free For All at the Central Nova Scotia Exhibition when 3,000 people were onlookers.

On the TV screen Thursday night one of the programs was a picture depicting an old time Exhibition with its livestock and amusements and a little boy who was getting a lamb ready to exhibit. It also showed an old-fashioned train pulling into a station and on one of the cars were the words Dan Patch and Dan was led down the ramp to the ground before the admiring gaze of hundreds of persons. Many thousands of race horses have come and gone and two names stand out in memory, Maud S., who holds the world's record to high wheels of 2:08 1/4 trotting and the other is Dan Patch, whose record of 1:55 1/4 remained tops on the book until 1938 when Billy Direct paced in 1:55 at Lexington, Kentucky.

So great was the popularity of Dan Patch that his appearance at any fair brought new record attendances and one fair day all world's records were broken with an estimated attendance of 80,000 people. No horses could be found to race against him so he gave exhibitions, racing against time and it was in one of these that he made the world's record that stood so long of 1:55 1/4. Dan Patch whose articles are so much looked forward to in Hoof Beats and who is Registrar of the USTA, remembers Dan Patch very well and told us of how kind he was and of how his father who was assistant trainer at International Stock Farm, gave most of his work to Dan. Ken's grandfather moved from Prince Edward Island to Minnesota and often told Ken stories of the Garden of the Gulf and its people.

Among the wins made by Miller last year was the Little Brown Jug, largest pacing purse in the world, that he won with Tar Heel, and he also won the Review Futurity with the same horse. He is the all time leading driver in placing horses in the 2:00 list with 18 and has a total of 34 miles in 2:00 or better to his credit.

The track committees of the Victoria Driving Club, St. Mathiasen, Doug MacLeod and Jack Mulligan, were down examining the ice on the North River Causeway Thursday and testing it for strength and found there was from 12 to 14 inch inches of solid ice. Of course it is covered with a foot of snow at present but that can be removed and it is planned to plough it and have it ready for racing next Wednesday afternoon. Horsemen wishing start will please send in their name as soon as possible to Secretary A.B. Cutcliffe.

This will be a good opportunity to test out speed for those who have the ambition to take part in the International Ice Races which will be held at Dartmouth, N.S. on February 9th and 10th. Dashes on the local speedway will be quarter miles as well as the dashes raced at Dartmouth, where they will have a free for all trot, purse \$1,000, a free for all pace, purse \$1,000 and an engraved cooler and trophy for the winner of each event. The above are being sponsored by the Eastern Driving Association of which Fred M. Lahey is president.

We were delighted to receive a calendar from Mr. and Mrs. J.C. Cameron of Smith Falls, Ontario, showing their great pacer, Ezra Dean 2:03 3-5 winning the \$10,000 pace at Blue Bonnets, Montreal, Sept. 2, 1956. Ezra is better than a 2:00 performer on a mile track and looks like one of the best pacing prospects in Canada. Another photo on the calendar shows Ezra with the winner's blanket on and Mr. A. Mrs. Cameron and the driver. They are being cheered and admired by over 10,000 spectators.
