VOLUME OF HOMEWORK SPARKS DISAGREEMENT

TORONTO (CP) - A psychologist and a university official disagree on how much homework is too much. Dr. Sam Luker, head of psychological school services in Guelph, Ont., says increased academic pressure is creating neuroticism among high school students. "It's amazing how many

tranquillizers," he said in an interview. "It's the only way they can get a breathing spell." A. R. Kilgour, director of admissions at the University of Toronto, said homework teaches the student to meet challenges. In an interview, he said: "Education involves meeting challenges and the sooner the student can learn to meet challenges and difficulties the better for his future education and career."

The two men were commenting on recent complaints to educational officials in the Toronto area by parents concerned about what they described as "excessive homework" thrust on high school students. Gary Cavanagh, a Toronto high school English teacher, said many students put in more hours than a nine-to-five worker. "You see youngsters who work themselves to the breaking point," he added. David Tough, a school superintendent in suburban

North York, said Grade 10 high school students should be required to study two to four hours each night. Many teachers interviewed said students who organize their home work, and keep up their review studies instead of letting it all pile up, should have no trouble.


