TORONTO, (CP) — Uranium marked up good gains Tuesday in the face of a generally weaker stock market as trading picked up. Volume totalled 5,240,000 shares. Losses of half a point on the exchange indexes in base metals and western oils were the largest at the close. Golds showed a minor dip.

Chimo was strong in the uranium prospects, gaining 35 cents in a turnover of 230,000 shares. New Delhi, Gunnar, Cons. Golden Arrow, Nesbitt and Beaverlodge also gained.

New Brunswick base metals held firm with no major advances. Brunswick gained a fraction and New Larder U added pennies.

Northern Ontario rare metal prospects gained as Inspiration and Tungsten rose.

Heaviest trader was God's Lake, a gold prospect, moving 44,000 shares to gain 10 cents. Eastern Metals added 32 cents in a turnover of 328,000 shares.

Western oils weakened. Losers were Pacific, Calvan, Canada Southern, Del Rio and Great Plains. Amurex added almost 1/2 and Central Explorers, Grodoff, Royalite and Canadian Oil Lands rose.

Base metals turned lower on losses in higher-priced issues as Falconbridge dropped 50 cents.

United Asbestos, Campbell Chibougamau, Hudson Jay and Noranda slipped but Cassiar, East Sullivan and Quebecmont gained.

Senior golds were mixed but juniors weakened. Strength in Pro-bisher buoyed holding companies although Ventures weakened after a firm opening.
