On Faculty Of Maritime School Of Social Work

Appointment of Miss Joan M. Smith, Montreal, to the faculty of the Maritime School of Social Work, was announced recently by L. T. Hancock, Director of the School.

A native of England, Miss Smith received her senior matriculation from Oxford High School and during World War II came to Canada. She had also lived in France, Denmark, Brazil and Portugal. After a short period with the Department of Pensions and National Health, she attended McGill University.

Miss Smith received her B.A. degree from McGill in 1945 and her Master of Social Work from the McGill School of Social Work in 1948. For seven years she worked with the Family Welfare Association of Montreal and also acted as unit supervisor and thesis advisor at McGill School of Social Work.

In 1952 she became director of the Social Service Department at the Hospital for the Mentally Ill in Verdun, Quebec. While at the hospital she introduced new services and lectured to student nurses, social workers and medical students. She also was the author of several articles in professional journals.

During the past two years she has made an intensive study of adolescent patients in an adult mental hospital.

The Maritime School of Social Work is the only School in the Atlantic Region offering a program of post-graduate training for social work. Because there is a grave shortage of trained social work personnel, the Maritime School of Social Work is playing a vital part in our Welfare programs by providing trained people to staff our agencies.

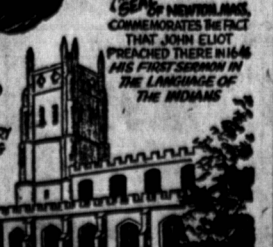
