There Ought To Be A Law



New York Stocks

NEW YORK. (AP)—The stock market stumbled badly last week but recovered itself and closed with a higher flourish.

On balance the market was lower—the first weekly loss in two months. The dip was not serious, and the modest rally that came in the final days of the week helped bullish sentiment in Wall Street considerably.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks closed the week at \$107.80, off 60 cents on the week.

The five most active issues last week on the New York stock exchange were RKO Theatres up 7-8 at 4 3-4 with 336,600 shares traded, United Corp down 1-8 at 5, Twentieth Century Fox up 1 7-8 at 19, Radio Corp. down 1 1-4 at 21 3-4 and American Telephone and Telegraph up 1 at 155 1-2.

Canadian stocks ended the week higher. International Nickel advanced 1-4 and Distillers Seagram rose 1-8. McIntyre slipped 1-8. On the American stock exchange Giant Yellowknife was off 1-4 and Royalite Oil was down 1-8.

REGINA, (CP)—Stan Curtis of Princeton, N. S., has been appointed livestock extension specialist with the Saskatchewan provincial animal industry branch, director E. E. Brockelbank announced Tuesday.

Mr. Curtis, a graduate of the University of Toronto, was a former instructor at the Nova Scotia Agricultural College. He will service Saskatchewan agricultural representatives, livestock breeders and organized groups in a general improvement program.

Management groups, on the other hand, don't feel the NLRB is going nearly fast enough in altering doctrines established by the old board under the Truman administration.

One important policy change concerns employers questioning their workers about union sympathies. The old NLRB held that any such questioning was in itself grounds for holding the employer guilty of unfair labor practice. But the new NLRB recently held it is not automatically illegal, indicating there must be accompanying evidence that the information was used to discriminate against the workers giving it.

There are a whole new series of decisions on NLRB jurisdiction. Farmer's idea is that the NLRB should leave a far greater number of cases to the states to settle.

At least one policy change might be regarded as favorable to unions. The old NLRB had ruled that contract clauses requiring workers to be union members were illegal unless the workers were given a 30-day "grace" period in which to join up.

The new NLRB has decided it won't outlaw a union shop clause lacking the grace period. Farmer pointed out that any worker denied the 30-day grace required by law can always bring unfair labor practice charges.

In still another reversal of past NLRB policy, the new NLRB has ruled that where there is an illegal strike employees must plainly disavow the walkout if they expect to have a legal right to get their jobs back.

QUEBEC, (CP)—For most of the troops on the liner Samaria when she docked Wednesday, there was one last good-bye to be said before going ashore.

The major said he is not sure if the dog will have to be quarantined before being allowed to stay in this country.

A friend is going to watch over Grook while Maj. Mulherin goes home, and then send him along when the dog is cleared.

Record Iron Ore Shipments

CLEVELAND, (AP)—Every ton of iron ore shipped down the Great Lakes in the remaining four or five weeks of this season will increase what is an all-time, one-season tonnage record.

The Lake Superior Iron Ore Association reported in the seven days up to Monday morning 1,778,487 tons of ore were transported, raising the 1953 tonnage to 32,720,346.

The previous record, set in the war year of 1942, was 92,076,781 tons.
