**Local and Other Items.**

**CITY TAXES.**—The defaulters list for City Taxes is now ready for publication, requested to pay up and have name taken off the list.

**Y. M. S. H.**—The Young Men's Social Hall committee met Saturday evening and decided that (1) No boys under 16 years of age will be admitted at all. (2) That for the present the hall will be open only three nights in the week, namely—Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday (3) The last half-hour of evening to be devoted to exercise of religious, temperance or scientific character.

**FORGERY TRIAL.**—Seven persons were tried at Amherst last Friday charged with having in their possession forged Dominion bills of the value of two dollars each. All pleaded guilty. The instigator in the counterfeit business who had \$500 in forged bills in his possession was sentenced to five years in the reformatory. Three were sentenced to \$100 fine or one year's imprisonment, and one to \$50 or six months.

**TREATED TO CIGARS.**—According to a White Plains, N. Y. despatch, among the certificates of expenses incurred by candidates in the recent election is that of Miss Bertha E. H. Barrett, who was elected school commissioner. She certifies that she contributed \$100 to the Republican County Committee! campaign buttons cost her \$34; photographs \$7; cards \$11; photographs and cuts \$8.50; carriage hire \$30.75; rent of hall \$11.50; substitute at school \$15; and cigars \$10.50. Her total expenses were \$325.61.
