**British Industry Gives Okay To Gov't Emergency Move**

**LONDON (CP)**—British industry has given general approval to the Labor government's emergency economic moves and one spokesman expressed hope they will be as effective as similar Canadian action two years ago.

Reporters were called to a press conference to hear Sir John G. Gifford, president of the British Chamber of Commerce, who said the government's move to improve the export-import situation.

Regarding new surcharges on imports, Sir Norman Kipping, federation director-general, said a similar levy imposed by Canada two years ago was "very effective, did not last long and I hope it will be the same way here."

The Canadian controls were lifted after nine months.

A statement issued by the three industrial groups, while endorsing the short-term action, said the longer-term aspects of the British government's plan require more study.
