

# Predicts Big Increase In Motor Traffic Congestion

TORONTO (CP)—See that traffic jam? It may get three times as big in 25 years. And watch out, say-walkers, there may be three road demons bearing down on you instead of one.

For in 25 years, Canada's sleek and speedy force of motor cars may almost triple, averaging one for every three Canadians, compared with one for every 4.2 last year. Only country ahead of Canada last year was the United States which had one for every 2.8 Americans.

Rhys M. Sale, president of the Ford Motor Company of Canada, predicted today that the total Canadian number of cars—on roads—roads which he described as inadequate and behind—will rise to about 9,200,000 by 1960 from 3,755,000 in 1955.

And with the big wartime and post-war crop of babies grown up and ready for their turn at the wheel, the motor car industry will continue to expand, said Mr. Sale, with annual sales rising in 1956 to about 956,000 from 450,000 last year.

**MR. PAUL McLAUGHLIN**  
Death came as an unexpected visitor to the community of Peake's on Thursday, Oct. 20th at ten a.m. and claimed as its victim Mr. Paul McLaughlin who suffered a heart attack which resulted in his death after his car left the road and went over an embankment near Peake's.

paid and materials purchased by Canadian motor car producers totalling more than \$500,000,000 in 1955, Mr. Sale said. Ford turned out 37 per cent of all the vehicles last year.

But while more and more cars were being injected into the roaring traffic stream, the Ford president said he was "appalled by the sheer economic cost of a national highway system that is years behind the times."

"Millions upon millions of dollars are being wasted annually as a result of traffic congestion, bad roads, limited parking space and other faults in the system," he told the Gordon economic commission.

And this was to "say nothing of a toll of human life and limb that can be attributed directly and indirectly to road conditions or ineffective traffic control."

## LOSING BATTLE

Canada in 1944 had 127,000 miles of surfaced highway, equal to one mile for every 11.3 vehicles. The surfacing extended to 191,000 miles in 1953, but the vehicles had increased and the mileage dropped to one to every 18 vehicles.

This, said Mr. Sale, was fighting a "losing battle." It was time Canadians got themselves a better road system, under long-term integrated planning. The most compelling need was to correct traffic congestion on key highways and cities across the country.

Insufficient roads and highways, added Mr. Sale, also have had effect on sales of cars and trucks. Ford didn't know how serious this was, but it was aware of it particularly in the big cities.

Another problem was the federal 10-per-cent excise tax. This was a "damning inheritance from the distant past when the automobile was looked upon as a pure luxury," Mr. Sale said the car owner already was loaded with innumerable taxes. The excise tax should be removed.

The death of Mr. Wilfred McGuigan, well-known plumber and master mechanic of Charlottetown occurred suddenly in the Charlottetown Hospital on Saturday Nov. 19, 1955, following his admission suffering from a heart condition which developed while working at repairs to a machine at Seaman's Beverage Co. He was 62 years of age.

Mr. McGuigan was a son of the late John McGuigan and Helen Trainor, both of Charlottetown. Following attendance at Queen Square School, he became an apprentice plumber with the late F. H.
