## The Centennial Plan Is Chain Topic

Three hundred delegates representing more than 19,000 members of the Catholic Women's League of Canada began a six-day annual convention yesterday at the Basilica Recreation Centre, Charlottetown.

A prominent discussion topic at the 46th annual convention is expected to centre around plans for a national centennial project.

Mrs. Herson Stevens, Calgary, National president of the CWL, said yesterday the project will be a unique contribution not proposed by any other group and if accepted by the convention, would affect people across the country.

Mrs. Stevens is likely to keep her centennial plan a secret until Thursday when it comes up at the afternoon tea at Government House, slated for 3.30.

A message from the National Development Board, announced Sunday night the engineering feasibility of tidal power development at Shepley Bay and Cumberland Basin, at the head of the Bay of Fundy, is indicated in the report, consulting engineers who carried out a site of foundation conditions.

Mr. MacKeigan, a Halifax lawyer, said the report showed satisfactory rock is available as a foundation for all structures at the Shepley Bay site at depths generally not more than 120 feet below mean sea level.

At Cumberland Basin, the rock slopes gradually to about the same depth except for a narrow zone of 800 feet in which it falls to 180 feet. The rock is a sound inter-bedded sedimentary formation of shales and sandstone, the report said.

The study, carried out by Roland Walker Ching of Shepley Engineering Corporation Ltd., was regarded "as a pre-requisite to consideration of tidal power development."

Mr. MacKeigan said the consultant states the study established the feasibility of the project, as far as sub-surface conditions are concerned, but more detailed engineering would be necessary before an estimate of capital costs and an assessment of economic feasibility could be made.

"It is quite obvious that it fully developed, this project would generate such a large body of power that it could not be absorbed in the Atlantic region at present time. This means, in effect, that a basic pre-requisite for the ultimate development of the project would be its integration with a much larger grid than is now available."

## Brainwashing Is Discussed

LONDON (Reuters) — Brainwashing and the emotional problems of war-born babies were discussed at a psychiatric meeting here.

The first congress on social psychiatry was told that brainwashing as practised by Communist China in the Korean War was a failure.

This view came from Dr. Harvey Bluestone of the New York City Community Medical Health Centre.

He said the technique worked on only 21 out of thousands of Americans captured by the Chinese in the Korean War.

The congress also was told that U.S. war babies, over 19 1/2 years old, have a higher rate of sex problems and are more emotionally vulnerable than other generations.

John E. Kysar and Misha S. Zaks, professors at the University of Illinois, told the congress many of the male war babies are continually striving to prove their strength, daring and sexual adequacy.

## Problems Of Dualism In Parishes Said Ignored By Lay Members

"If the parish fails to adapt and adjust to a changing society, it places the parishioner in the difficult and awkward position of living in two different worlds," to which he must make two different kinds of adjustment. He must adapt to one form of government in his secular community, and just as readily conform to another form of government in his ecclesiastical community," John Eldon Green, lecturer in the philosophy department of Dalhousie University told delegates at the third annual general Social Life Conference which concluded in Corner Brook, Nfld., yesterday.

Mr. Green was one of the four main speakers at the conference. His paper was entitled "Socialization and Parish Life."

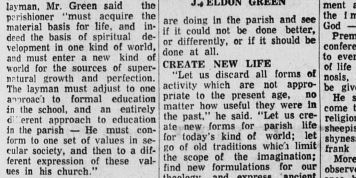
Developing the theme of the conference was the role of today's layman. Mr. Green said the parishioner "must acquire the material basis for life, and he must be able to do so in the development of his spiritual growth and perfection. The layman must find one approach to formal education in the school, and an entirely different approach to education in the parish — He must conform to a set of values in his secular society, and then to a different expression of these values in his church."

NO MATURE ROLE

Mr. Green said the lay members in the parish resolve the problem by pretending it is not there. They conform to what is required in parish life, and then participate, usually without effort or pull, in the very things which as parishioners they condemn.

"The modern Roman Catholic layman is fully at home neither in parish nor community. He does not enjoy a mature role in the Church, and he experiences a certain disloyalty and even hostility in identifying with the state, as in Church and State, the parish and the community, were natural enemies rather than partners in achieving the common good, and in creating the kind of world in which men may discover their purpose and their perfection."

The speaker suggested that the church should heed the words of the late Pope John: "Let us open the windows and let in the life." He said we should look at everything we

are doing in the parish and see if it could not be done better, or differently, or if it should be done at all.

Let us discard all forms of activity which are not appropriate to the present age, so that we may be useful in the past," he said.
