## CAREERS WITH GOVERNMENT OF CANADA

Applicants must register for all programs prior to October 15th, 1979.

Application forms are available at the Canada Employment Centre on Campus, Main Building. Students interested in the Foreign Service Program must write the Foreign Service Exam on Saturday, October 13th. No General Exam this year.
