NEW YORK

NEW YORK (AP) — The stock market dropped moderately Monday. News that Venezuela is increasing taxes and royalties of oil firms to 60 per cent from 50 knocked down stock prices of companies immediately concerned and also affected other international oils. Investors apparently feared the same idea might spread to the oil rich Middle East.

Royal Dutch Shell was the biggest trader, dropping 1 1/2 to 46 1/2. The Associated Press 60 - stock index fell 70 cents to \$209.20. International Nickel was a point lower in the Canadian list. Aluminum Ltd., Canadian Pacific, Distillers - Seagrams, Hudson Bay Mining and McIntyre Porcupine also declined. Ahead were Dome Mines and Walker-Gooderham.
